CHETWYND'S SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT



Last week's frosty temperatures didn't stop Chetwynd's Sewage Treatment Plant from officially being commissioned this past Friday, December 9th. With the help of MP Bob Zimmer, Mayor Nichols and Councillor Laura Weisgerber, the ribbon, or rather, toilet paper was cut. The choice to use toilet paper was a clear winner in my books, being more than fitting for the occasion.

The 4.5 million dollar project was finished on time and on budget. The District of Chetwynd received two-thirds of the funding from the Building Canada Small Communities Fund and the Province of British Columbia.

The Sewer Treatment Plant consists of 3 concrete aeration tanks with the capacity to provide service to 4000 people. The concrete pad was built with room for a fourth cell in the future, bringing capacity numbers up to 5500-6000 people. High-tech computers were installed that have a back up system and hydro carbon alarms. Communications are tied in and employees are able to access and view screens from the water plant instead of driving the distance to the Sewage Treatment Plant.





The system is now a lot more efficient and affective. The previous aeration system was prone to failure in the winter months, whereas the new system pumps air beneath the surface that makes for less issues, and less smell I might add.

Before the upgrades, B.O.D levels (biological oxygen demand) were double the permit level, but with time and help, The District of Chetwynd was able to keep a promise made 4 years ago to the Ministry of Environment and have now brought levels from 60+ down to 7. That number could drop even lower in the summer months when the system isn't running constantly and Mother Nature can assist.

All of these improvements will help reduce the quantity and improve the quality of treated water flowing into the Pine River, making for a safer and healthier community.
