#### BE A TOURIST IN YOUR OWN TOWN MONTH



The Visitor's Centre held a free BBQ on Friday to kick off "Be a Tourist in Your Own Town Month" here in Chetwynd, the first of several planned activities. The weather was less than cooperative but spirits were high as burgers and dogs were dished out to anyone wanting to experience Chetwynd from a fresh perspective. Other events will include a car rally, a geocaching challenge, and family bike rides along the town trails, all as a part of the launch of IMAGINE Chetwynd. The program will see several items made available at the Visitor's Centre and the Tansi Friendship Centre that can be borrowed free of charge, such as a tandem bicycle, basketballs, footballs, tennis rackets, walking sticks, bear bells, fishing rods, and more. People who borrow anything are encouraged to post their experience on the IMAGINE Chetwynd Facebook page to spread the word about the sorts of gear the program has to offer. Tyria Plamondon, Manager of the Visitor's Centre, said the goal was to "have the local explore Chetwynd," and hopes that the Facebook page will see "people inspiring other people" to get to know their town a little better. Goods but will soon also be available from the Visitor's Centre for anyone wanting to borrow the fishing rods.

## CHETWYND CHAINSAW CARVERS – PROFILES

In advance of the Chetwynd International Chainsaw Carving Competition the Coffee Talk Express will be running profiles of the carvers you'll see in action from June 9-12.

JORDAN ANDERSON



Jordan Anderson grew up in Minnesota as an outdoor enthusiast, working on log homes with his father before moving to Alaska in 2005 and beginning his carving career shortly after arriving. His carving talents have taken him to competitions around the world, from North America to Europe and even down to Australia. "I grew up doing lots of wildlife drawings, nautical themes and aquatic life," said Anderson, and he's made the nautical theme his speciality, something he says helps set him apart from other carvers. He used that theme to great effect during last year's competition with an incredible sailfish carving, which he had drawn up a month beforehand and had "brewing in my mind for a while," something he said gives a carver a real advantage.

Upon first moving to Alaska he was not immediately taken by the chainsaw carvings, "because I was more of an artist or sculptor type of mindset." After seeing how profitable the art form was, however, he took an interest and soon began to appreciate the more intricate artwork practiced by the premier carvers around the world. "I look at a lot of YouTube video and carvers online like Chris Foltz and Bob King who I looked up to because they were doing more than just a little chainsaw carving," said Anderson, "they were making sculptures." Becoming a carver changed Anderson's life immediately, noting that "it's been surreal in the past few years because I was an up-an-comer, and I still feel like that sometimes, but now I go to other countries where people who've never met me have seen my work and watch my YouTube videos."

Regarding this year's competition, Anderson has a few ideas in mind but wouldn't reveal anything, thinking it akin to a magician not revealing his tricks. He is well prepared,

however, saying that he is "always brainstorming and I have a couple crazy ideas in mind but it depends on how the wood looks, how it's shaped and the integrity of it," as all of those things will determine what he's actually going to make. He loves the atmosphere he finds in Chetwynd and said he is honoured to be included, calling it "an epic place for one of the best competitions in the world." "Nothing really measures up to Chetwynd and the feeling that you get from that event," he continued, and said his favourite memory from last year (his first time to Chetwynd) was "the comradery of being there and being part of the carving family there." He admits it's going to be hard to top his carving from last year because of how smooth everything went for him, but no matter what he'll be enjoying the time spent with his fellow carving icons. "That's what's so exciting about these competitions," he him, but no matter what he'll be enjoying the time spent with his fellow carving record and their brand new bag of tricks and you always go home with something new to try."


