THREE HUNDRED JOBS LOST IN NORTHEAST BC LAST MONTH

The unemployment rate in Northeast B.C. took a leap of more than a percentage point to nearly six per cent in May.

According to BC Statistics, the unemployment rate for this corner of the province hit 5.9 per cent last month, up sharply from 4.7 per cent posted for April. That translates to a loss of approximately 300 from the Northeast part of the province's workforce of 40,100.

This marks the third straight month unemployment has risen in the region. The unemployment rate sat at just 4.2 per cent in March, with 41,100 people reported as working.

The information comes from Statistic Canada's most recent monthly Labour Force Survey, released on Friday, June 5th. According to that survey, overall unemployment in B.C. took a small dip, down from 6.3 to 6.1 per cent for May. Stats Canada says employment increased by 31,000 in the province last month, most of which was part-time work.

Kelowna appears to be sitting with the lowest unemployment in the province at 4.7 per cent. The Cariboo region posted the highest unemployment figures for May, according the survey, sitting at 7.7 per cent for the month, another sharp increase from 6.7 per cent posted for the


region in April.



MEET THE MAYOR June 12, 2015

With the Fair Share negotiations behind us (the new agreement will be known affectionately as the Peace River Agreement [PRA]) and Chetwynd's funding future more or less predictable for a couple of decades, what reasonable expectations can you have about how it will be allocated over the next five years? Five years is a long time to predict with any certainty. Five minutes is just about as difficult given our mortality. So we'll pinch off our natural hubris and restrict ourselves to a planning process: looking into the future, this, then, is how our PRA funds could be invested.

For starters, on the advice of Administration, Council sets aside 10% of the grant to build a reserve fund as a hedge against emergencies which, planning notwithstanding, will come in some guise. Council believes it is best to be as prepared as possible before the crisis hits.

You may know (or merely guess) that there is a lot of stuff out of sight that needs to be fixed. You're right, absolutely right, as you negotiate our streets. (I was driving about on our streets the other day and it didn't take much extra insight to recognize that a few of our problems are quite in sight. In fact, it doesn't even require 20-20 vision to spot them.)

Street rehabilitation is already in the works with planned allocations of \$600,000 per year. That represents between 20% and 23% of the total PRA allocation each year. It's not a shabby commitment but there is still room to invest more.

The East Trunk Main has been in the ground longer than most of us have been walking this sod. What should that tell you? For one thing, it should tell you that there are a few wrinkles in the system that can't be fixed by a little cosmetic cream washed from your faces. There is serious work costing serious dollars that will have to be done before another decade becomes history. Thanks to PRA, Council can plan the stages of work and carry it to completion.

Sidewalks need to be built in many parts of the community. The east-west boulevard paved walking trail needs to be completed. It is a work of several years. Recreational trails require continual maintenance and extension. Where shall we stop? I don't suppose there will come a time when we can say *It's finished. There's nothing more to do. Time to rest from our labours.* (Of course that time comes for all of us.)

There is more to do and when all of that is done it will be time to start over. We live under the cruel second law of thermodynamics where the principle of entropy applies to all people and to everything we build or plant in the ground. Sooner or later, usually sooner, it has to be fixed or replaced. We neglect the fixing, done with operations funds, not PRA money, at the risk of greater cost for sooner replacing.






