



Council Meeting September 16

The regular meeting of the District of Chetwynd council took place Monday afternoon with the Mayor and all councillors were in attendance with the exception of Rochelle Galbraith.

The meeting began with the introduction of Fire Chief Curtis Redpath, who thanked the town for welcoming him to the community, and says so far everyone has been very accommodating and that he looks forward to working with everyone.

Mayor and Council moved along to discuss a Traffic Regulation Amendment Bylaw discussed briefly at last Council's meeting. This amendment proposes the stopping of parking on public roadways between October and May. If this amendment passes- Parking on roads designated as snow removal routes could potentially see your vehicle get towed. Councillor Laura Weisgerber spoke against the motion, stating her concern that the proposal is unfair to residents as well as mentioning how other communities deal with the issue of unplowed roads due to parked vehicles. Mayor Allen Courtoreille suggested tabling the motion and coming up with another solution. After a vote, it was decided that the motion will be tabled until a new plan has been reached to deal with the issue.

Mayor and council went on to announce a public hearing to consider Proposed Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 1100. The hearing will take place on October 7th at 4:00 at council chambers. The amendment proposes changing the zoning for property at 5100 Nicholson Road (empty lot beside Conuma's parking lot) from Multiple Family Residential to Highway Commercial.


