CHETWYND MECHANICAL PULP TO RESUME PRODUCTION IN JANUARY

Paper Excellence Canada says that a routine maintenance shutdown at the Chetwynd Mechanical Pulp Mill in September will now be prolonged.

In a release, the company says the decision to extend the shutdown will give the company the opportunity to make operational improvements on the mill.

Paper Excellence's Deputy CEO Pedro Chang says the company is committed to the mill, its employees and the community. The mill will be closed for the coming months hoping the closure and improvements will lead to the operation's long-term success.

The mill reopened in the spring after a \$50 million upgrade, as Paper Excellence purchased the facility from Tembec in 2014.

The company plans to return to production in January 2016.

ADVANCE POLL TURNOUT NEARLY DOUBLES COMPARED TO 2011

Apparently voter apathy isn't entirely a thing in the Peace Region.

Elections Canada has a first round of estimates for the number of electors in this federal election's advance voting days, saying that 10,878 voters cast their ballot at the polls in the Prince George-Peace River-Northern Rockies riding.

On the other side of the border in Alberta, the Grande Prairie-Mackenzie riding saw 8,626 advance voters head to the polls.

In the last federal election, Elections Canada counted 38,671 ballots cast in total, a voter turnout of 54%. Almost 15 million votes were cast in total nationwide, with a turnout of 61.1%. There were an estimated 3.6 million people that voted on the weekend, 507,920 of those voters were from BC.




