









Dawson Creek RCMP seek tips on 45 year old missing person case

Dawson Creek RCMP are requesting the public's assistance in a 45 year old missing person investigation.

On August 15th, 1974, the detachment received a report of a missing male from a family member in Fort St. John.

Murphy Williams was last seen around 3 AM on August 15th at a farm residence near Mile 30 on the Alaska Highway, where he had been working for the previous two days.

It is reported that Williams was "acting strangely"

throughout the night and when the farmer at the residence woke up around 7:30 that morning, Williams was not located. A search of the property and the surrounding area turned up negative.

Williams, who was 35 years old at the time of his disappearance, is described as Aboriginal, approximately 5'8" and about 170 pounds.

The detachment reports that multiple resources have been utilized in this case, including RCMP Police Dog Services, RCMP Air Support Services and Search and Rescue.

Anyone with information on Williams' location or his disappearance is asked to contact the Dawson Creek RCMP detachment or Crime Stoppers.

Roasted Trout with Mango Avacado Salsa ^{4 servings / 25 min} Ingredients

For trout: 4 (120 g/4-oz) trout fillets Canola oil cooking spray 1 Juice of 1 lemon 1 tbsp (15 mL) canola oil 1/4 tsp (1 mL) ground black pepper 2 lemons, whole Directions For trout: Preheat oven to 375° F (190° C).

For salsa: 1 mango, peeled and cut into 1/2 inch cubes 1 medium avocado, peeled and cut into 1/2 inch cubes 1/2 red onion, diced 1 tbsp (15 mL) lime juice 1 tbsp (15 mL) canola oil 1 tsp (5 mL) chili pepper powder 2 tbsp (30 mL) cilantro, chopped



Spray a 9 x 9 inch (22 x 22 cm) roasting pan or baking sheet with the canola oil spray. Place fillets inside and coat them with lemon juice, canola oil and pepper.

Slice whole lemons into thin rounds, and remove seeds from each slice. Distribute slices equally among trout fillets.

Roast fillets for 15-20 minutes, depending on thickness of fillets. Fish should be translucent and flakes easily when pulled apart.

For salsa: Place mango, avocado, onion, lime juice, canola oil, chili powder, cilantro in a small mixing bowl and mix to combine. Salsa will keep in the refrigerator for two to three days.

Gambling profits down in Dawson Creek and Fort St. John

The BC Lottery Corporation reports that gambling revenues in Fort St. John and Dawson Creek experienced a decrease last year.

As reported by Alaska Highway News, revenues generated at the two Chances gaming centres were about \$28.99 million in 2018-19, which is down slightly from 2016-17's total of \$29.67 million.

Slots dominated revenues in both locations, bringing in \$15.1 million in Fort St. John and \$12.35 million in Dawson Creek in 2018-19. In Fort St. John, bingo brought in \$116,000, which is down from \$257,000. Bingo suffered a similar fate in Dawson Creek, bringing in \$157,000 in 2018-19, which is down from \$477,000 from the previous year.
