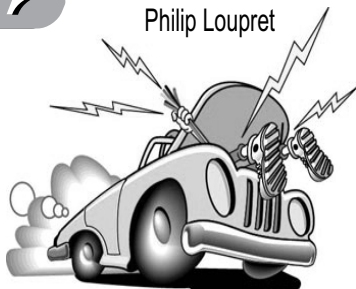

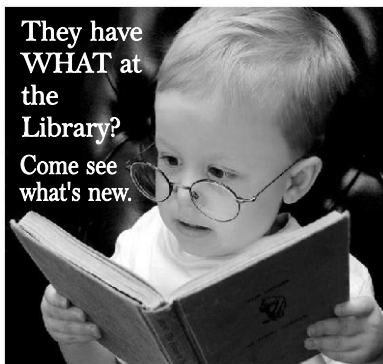

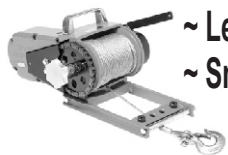

## POPPY CAMPAIGN 2017

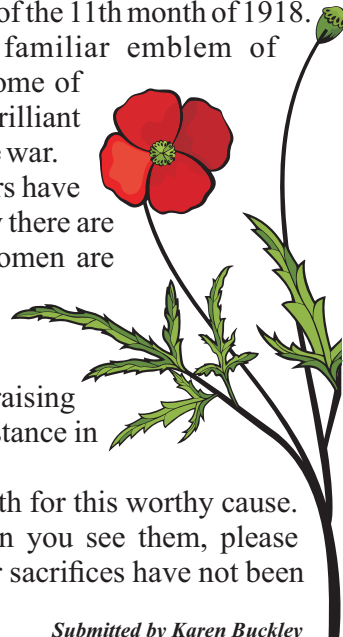
