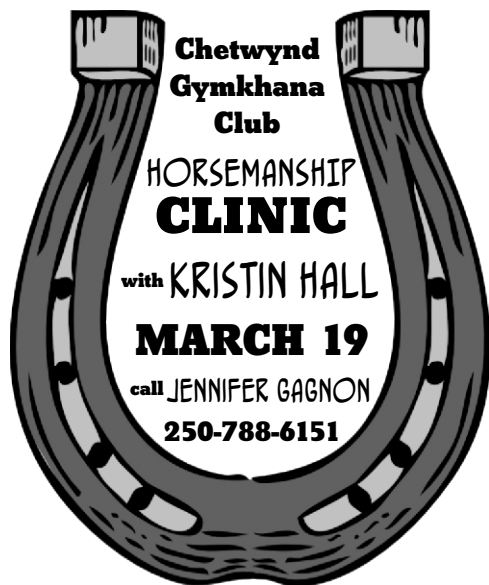

IS IT TIME TO RETURN YOUR RADON KIT?

As winter winds down, Northern Health is reminding people who are testing their homes or businesses for radon to send in their radon test to the appropriate testing site. The timeline for sending in your individual kit will depend on how long you wish to test. Testing should occur for a minimum of three months and include time during the winter months.

If you purchased your radon kit from a Northern Health facility, drop it off at your local health unit and we will ship it for you. If you purchased it from radonaware.ca or another source, please follow the shipping instructions on the package. Once you receive your results, a Northern Health Environmental Health Officer would be pleased to discuss follow up options.

Radon is a radioactive, invisible, odourless gas that can seep into your home through cracks in floors, walls and foundations. You can't see, smell or taste radon. But when radon seeps into a closed-in space like a house, it can be harmful. This is why it is important for people to test homes and businesses so that they know if radon levels could be harmful.

"One in 20 people who are exposed to radon gas over a long period of time are at risk of developing lung cancer," said Dr. Sandra Allison, Northern Health chief medical health officer. "We want northerners to understand their test results, and ensure that they take the appropriate steps to reduce radon levels in their homes if necessary."

Exposure to the combination of radon gas and cigarette smoke creates a greater risk of lung cancer than exposure to either factor alone. A person who smokes or used to smoke and is exposed to high levels of radon over many years has a 1 in 3 chance of developing lung cancer. For non-smokers, the risk is 1 in 20.

It is recommended that those people whose homes or businesses test high for radon hire a certified radon mitigation specialist. A fix usually costs between \$1,500 and \$3,000 depending on your home.

"No one should have to suffer from radon-induced lung cancer. And to ensure no one does, testing for indoor radon – and finding out if your home has a problem - is a vital first step," said Scott McDonald, CEO of the BC Lung Association. "About now, most people who tested their homes this past fall and winter will begin receiving their radon test results. We're hopeful those whose levels exceed the Health Canada safety guideline will take action and mitigate."

The winter is the best time to test for radon, however test kits are still available through the BC Lung Association website radonaware.ca, or through Northern Health at your local health unit.

Taking place this year on July 30th & 31st, the line-up boasts a range of artists to suit a variety of tastes, beginning with a free Battle of the Bands on Friday, July 29th. The contest will feature a band competition as well as a vocalist competition, with the vocalist winner playing the main stage the following day at 12:30 pm and the winning band on Sunday, also at 12:30 pm.

Officially opening up the festival at 1:30 pm will be Vancouver's Pigeon Park, whose anthemic rock stylings helped them win Vancouver radio station CFOX's Seeds competition in 2013. Previous winners include Nickelback, Matthew Good, Bif Naked, Default and Theory of a Deadman, so don't be surprised if Pigeon Park becomes the next big Canadian band. The remaining Saturday slots are still being determined so you can expect more announcements in the months to come on the GrizFest website.

Saturday's 9 pm headliner will be Canadian legend Tom Cochrane and his band Red Rider, most famous for his 1991 hit "Life Is A Highway." The GrizFest date is part of a tour promoting *Take It Home*, his first album in a decade, on which he says he tried to "pay homage to many of my early southern influences like JJ Cale, The Band, Ry Cooder and Captain Beefheart." This Canadian icon is sure to draw a big crowd, so fans wanting a key location up front should plan to be there a little early.

Opening the festival's second day at 1:30 pm are Oshawa, Ontario rock duo The Standstills, who made a name for themselves by winning Ontario's Rocksearch battle of the bands previously won by The Trews, My Darkest Days and Finger Eleven. There may be only two people in the band, but you'd never know based on the intensity of their sound. If you want to hear some heavy shredding with a strong blues influence, make sure you're not late that Sunday.

Following them at 3 pm will be Vancouver's Art of Dying, whose gritty vocal style is instantly recognizable to fans of Nickelback and Theory of a Deadman. They were discovered by Disturbed guitarist Dan Donegan, who felt such a connection to the passion of their music that they ended up opening for Disturbed on a recent tour. Frontman Jonny Hetherington says he wants people to leave their shows feeling inspired so anyone in need of a pick-me-up should make sure to catch their set.

Hitting the stage Sunday at 5 pm are Akron, Ohio's Red Sun Rising, whose style blends classic rock elements with more modern, alternative sounds. Single "Emotionless" recalls alternative metal giants Tool with its tribal drumming, prog-inspired riffs and particularly the expressive vocals of frontman Mike Protich. Red Sun Rising is tailor-made for rock fans who want their headbanging to be slightly more cerebral.

7 pm will see North Muskegon, Michigan's veteran rockers Pop Evil take the stage. The band has opened for major acts like Whitesnake and Judas Priest and have had their music featured in videos with UFC fighter Frank Mir, the 2011 Stanley Cup Finals, the 2011 NFC Championship Game post-game show, NASCAR and ESPN's SportsCenter. With hard-driving vocals and metal-inspired riffs, Pop Evil are sure to make a few eardrums ring with their set.

Closing the festival at 9 pm are Montreal's Simple Plan, who have enjoyed enormous success with their pop-punk sound both in and outside of Canada. Their newest album *Taking One For The Team* features their classic sound with a few twists, such as a cameo from rapper Nelly on the song "I Don't Wanna Go To Bed," an acoustic ballad, reggae rhythms and even a punk anthem with a piano interlude. Their high-energy act is sure to end 2016's GrizFest on a high note, and luckily August 1st is a holiday so everyone can recover.

IMPORTANT NEWS FOR THIS SPRING

Over the past two weeks, the District of Chetwynd has received complaints of smoke generated from open burning from residents within the District of Chetwynd and within the Fire Protection Area. Residents complained of breathing difficulties caused by lingering smoke.

It is critical to note that trash, rubbish, any rubber or plastic material are not permitted to be burned in the Province of British Columbia and violations in this regard will be reported to the Ministry of the Environment.

The District of Chetwynd has a bylaw in place to control wood burning appliances, open air burning and fugitive dust control.

For land clearing and special projects, please apply for a Class "A" Permit (not to exceed 10 cubic meters). You may apply to the District Office for this permit and the Fire Chief or his designate will approve the permit by visiting the site. The permit is only good for the date of the burn and all regulations must be followed including venting rules and the extinguishment of any "smokes" after 24 hours of burning.

For minor cleanup, a Class "B" permit is required and fires are limited to 1 square meter in size. Smoke from these fires can also be toxic so homeowners are requested to consider "recycling" of the wood waste material. You may apply to the District Office for this permit and the Fire Chief or his designate will approve the permit by visiting the site. The permit is only good for the date of the burn and all regulations must be followed including venting rules and the extinguishment of any "smokes" after 24 hours of burning.

Care and control of fires in our fire protection area is critical along with consideration towards neighbours and friends. For more information, feel free to call Chief Leo Sabulsky at 250-788-6344 or email lsabulsky@gochetwynd.com.
