TAKE CARE OF YOUR SKIN

Melanoma is the most common and deadly form of cancer in Canada and has been on the rise for the past decade, the numbers are staggering:

- 7,300 Canadians will be diagnosed with melanoma skin cancer this year. 4,000 men and 3,300 women.
- This year approximately 1,250 Canadians will die from melanoma.

90% of melanoma cases are directly linked to UV exposure. So who's at highest risk? Everyone is at risk of developing life threatening skin cancer but some are at higher risk than others. People with weak immune systems, fair skin, eyes and hair. People who work in the sun, those who have had a blistering sunburn in their lifetime, people who have moles, asymmetrical or otherwise, and of course people who use tanning beds frequently.

Tanned skin is damaged skin! Although a nice tan can make you feel and look good, it can also age you, and drastically increases your risk of developing skin cancer.

It's important to lower your risk of skin cancers like melanoma, squamous cell carcinoma and even cataracts by applying an SPF30, or higher, sunscreen frequently throughout the day. Seek out a shady spot for those days at the beach, swim in the sun, hang out in the shade. Wear a wide brim hat and consider a loose fitting sun cover to help cover some skin from the sun.

If you notice new, or changing spots on your skin be sure to have them checked out by a physician as soon as possible. Here are a few tips to recognizing melanoma:

- -A- Asymmetry, is the spot uneven either in size, shape or height?
- B- Border, does it have a rough edge or is it a perfect circle? A rough edge could indicate melanoma.
- C- Colour, does it have consistent colour throughout or do the colours vary?
- D- Diameter, is it over 6mm across (the width of a pencil eraser)
- E- Evolving, has that spot grown, changed shape or colour or has a burning/tingling sensation?

Early diagnosis is your best chance at beating melanoma, which has been classified as

one of the most difficult cancers to treat. Do your skin a favour and protect yourself from the sun so you don't become another statistic.



Upcoming transmission line works for the Site C project


