WINTER TIRE REQUIREMENTS NOW IN EFFECT

The BC provincial government would like to remind motorists that winter tire regulations went into effect on Sunday, October 1st.

Anyone who is driving on designated highways in the province will be required to have winter tires that are labelled with either the Mountain Snowflake symbol or the Mud and Snow (M+S) symbol.

The law requires that all winter tires have a tread depth of 3.5 millimeters, and must be used on designated routes until March 31st. Drivers who fail to follow this rule can face a fine of \$121.00.

NEW POLL SHOWS SUPPORT FOR SITE C

A new Angus Reid survey suggests support for continuing construction on the Site C Dam.

The survey was released just a few days before the BCUC community input session in Prince George.

According to the survey, 45% of British Columbians support moving forward with construction of Site C, with 27% favouring cancellation of the project. 28% are undecided. So far, the Site C Dam project has cost 1.8 billion dollars, and requires another 7 billion dollars to complete construction. A recent report suggesting cancelling the project and remediation of the site would cost 1.1 billion dollars, with unknown additional penalties for cancelling the contract. The BCUC community input session was Friday September 29 at the Ramada Hotel

in Prince George. BCUC will release their final report on November 1st with estimates of costs for completion, suspension, or cancellation of the project.



ICBC WARNS CLIENTS ABOUT TEXTING SCAM

The Insurance Corporation of British Columbia is cautioning its customers of a texting scam after multiple clients reported receiving texts from the company.

The messages claim that the receiver has been sent a refund for a ticket or traffic fine, and provides a link to claim the money.

The link that users are sent to asks clients to enter their personal banking information. The scam is designed to trick people into unknowingly sending personal information or downloading malware onto their cell phone.
