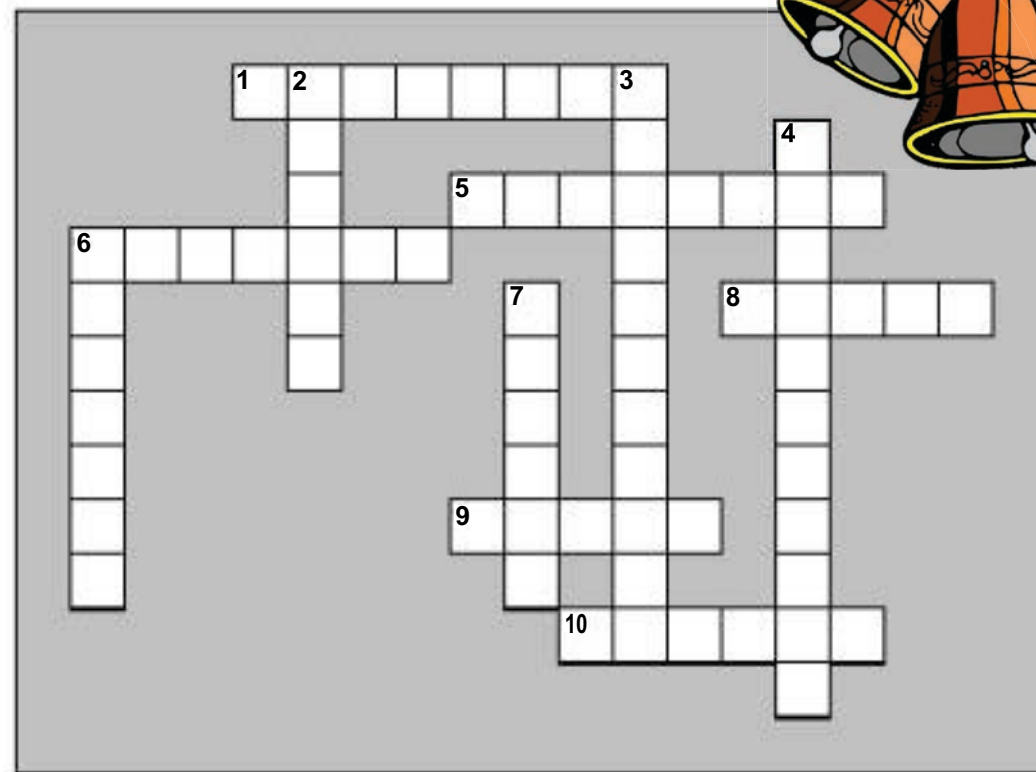

"Glory to God in the highest,

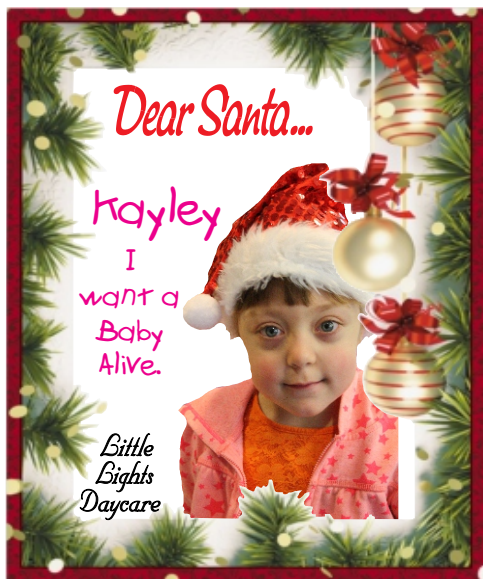
And on earth peace among men with whom He is pleased."

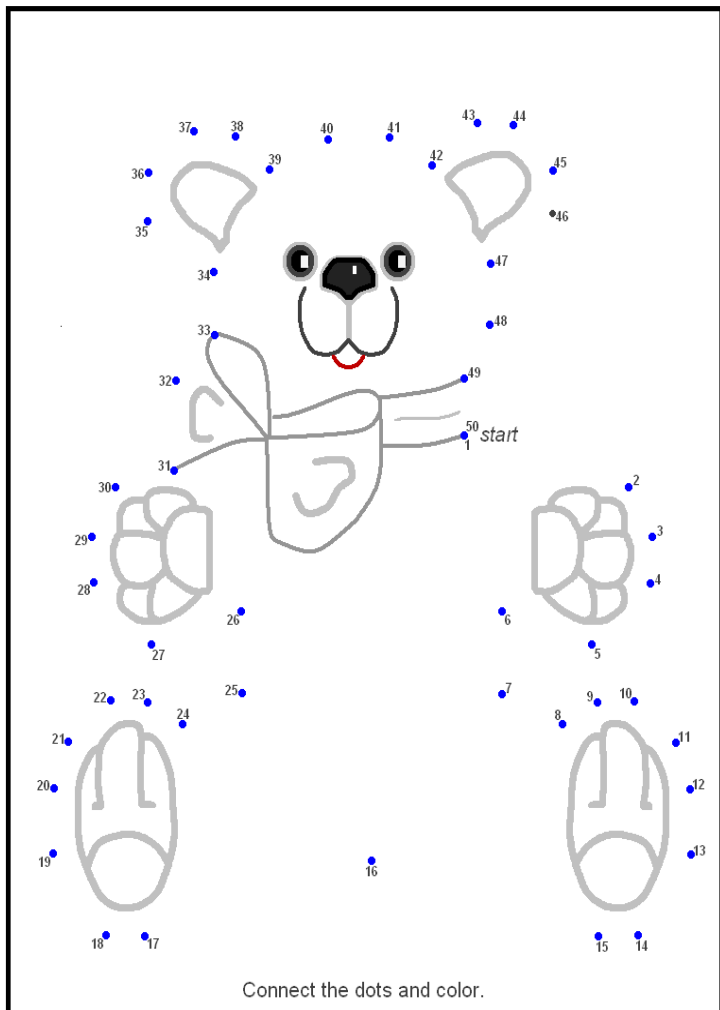
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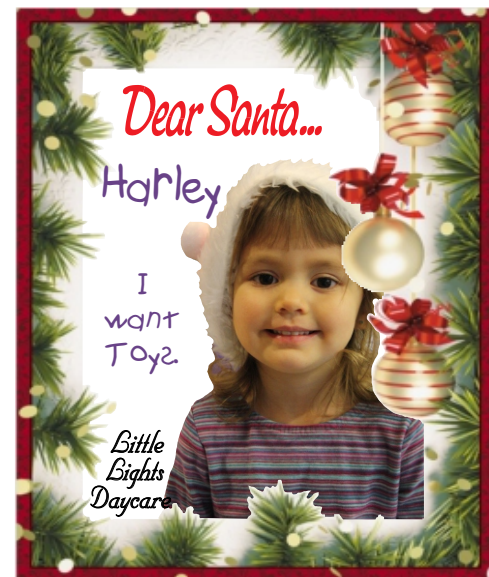




### CHRISTMAS EGGNOG ICE CREAM RECIPE
