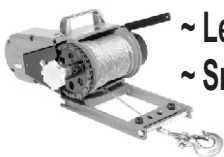

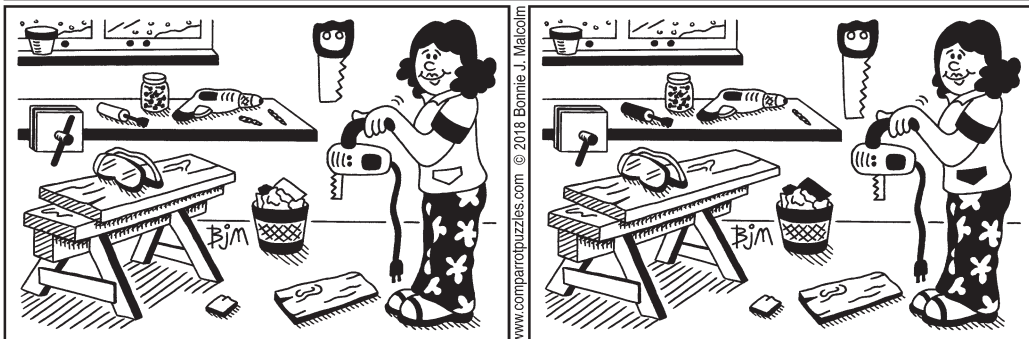

The Legion has had its fair share of issues with their buildings in the past few years. This repair is significant and will be completed with the help of grant money. A few helpful companies in town are helping out by donating items to aid with the big costs of the repairs.
