ANNUAL CHAINSAW CARVI **CHAMPIONSHIP CONCLUDES**








The 2015 Chetwynd International Chainsaw Carving Competition concluded Sunday afternoon with a large crowd in attendance.

DRIVERS MUST KEEP **RIGHT ON MULTI-**LANE HIGHWAYS

As of last week, drivers will now need a good reason to travel in the left lane on high-speed, multi-lane highways throughout the province of British Columbia.

New regulations have come into effect that will clarify rules regarding travelling in the left lane. Drivers on multi-lane highways where the speed is more than 80 kilometres per hour must stay to the right unless they are:

Overtaking and passing another vehicle.

Moving left to allow traffic to merge.

Preparing for a left hand turn.

Moving left to pass an official vehicle displaying a flashing light.

The exception to these rules are during periods of congestion, when the actual travel speed drops to 50 kilometres per hour or less. Drivers are encouraged to use the left-most lane to keep traffic flowing. Police can ticket drivers who should not be travelling in the left-most lane. The fine is \$167, with three driver penalty points.

In addition, new laws will allow the ministry to define winter tires, studded tires and traction devices such as chains in regulation.

Another change will permit local governments to permit motorcycle parking within six metres of intersections with stop signs or signals, as long as drivers' views are not impeded. This will allow more efficient use of space that is not large enough for a car.



CHETWYND COUNCIL ALLOWS VENDORS ON STREETS UNTIL END OF THE SEASON

The District of Chetwynd held a Regular Council meeting yesterday afternoon in the Cottonwood Hall at the Chetwynd Rec Centre with Councilors Brownlee and Bassendowski in absence.

The first delegation was from the Chetwynd Circus North, who thanked the Council for their donation of \$2,000 towards the camp and included a slideshow of the Circus camp. Approximately 50 kids were at the event, which was at full capacity. The kids raised \$1,700 at a concession, which will allow another 10 spots in next year's program, in addition to another instructor.

The second delegation consisted of two BC Hydro employees providing an Update on the Site C Clean Energy Project. The delegation gave updates on the procurements that were awarded for Worker Accommodation and Clearing of the South Bank of the Peace River. The Hydro delegation also gave information regarding upcoming open houses regarding the Site C Project, one of which will be occurring in Chetwynd on July 15th at the Chetwynd Rec Centre and will be open to the public. Councilor Ernest Pfanner voiced concern about the lack of knowledge regarding the hauling of materials to the dam site. According to Hydro, whether materials will be hauled from the West Pine Quarry via truck along the Jackfish Lake Road or via rail to the site was one of the chief points of contention. Hydro stated that that decision will rest with the main dam construction contractor, the contract of which hasn't been awarded. Councilor Pfanner and Mayor Nichols also had questions regarding the effects on fish migration and mercury levels in both the Peace and Moberly Rivers.

Council also passed resolution CR-7a, which was intended by Mayor Nichols to withdraw the resolution regarding mobile



Those vendors will now be permitted to conduct business on District property until the end of the summer season. District CAO Doug Fleming stated that no party can obstruct any District road without the express permission of the District Chief Engineer, and stated that snow removal would preclude those vendors operating during periods of snowfall.


In attendance were several members of the public, including the proprietors of Mama G's Country Kitchen, one of the previously affected mobile vendors, and Robert Link, the owner of Murray's Pub & Kitchen. The party from Mama G's questioned Council about their perceived hasty decision during the meeting on June 1st, and implored Council to research the matter to the fullest extent before passing a final resolution. Link, who employs a staff of 23, felt that though his correspondence to Council may have been poorly worded, he was undeserving of the large amount of negative attention directed his way, a point which was echoed by Councilor Weisgerber. After passing the resolution, and at Councilor Deck's insistence, Council stated that they will be spending a period of time to come up with a positive resolution to the food truck question.

Finally, Council followed through on a recommendation that Dayton Waldie and Kayla Sanford will be the recipients of the 2015 Youth Leadership Scholarship Program, valued at \$2,500 each (\$1,250 per year for 2015 and 2016), which they can claim upon notification of their enrolment at a post-secondary institute.
