Council Meeting November 19th A Public Hearing and Council Meeting was held in the District Chambers this past Monday,

A Public Hearing and Council Meeting was held in the District Chambers this past Monday, November 19th. The public hearing was to allow Chetwynd's residents to voice their questions and concerns regarding a few extra clarifications that were added to bylaw 1081 regarding cannabis. The new legislation clarifies that residents can apply for a retail cannabis license but residents also have the ability to farm cannabis within town limits as well as store cannabis. No one spoke for, or in opposition of the bylaw.

The Council Meeting began with an informative and inspirational update from Chetwynd's Visitor Centre. Tyria Plamondon, from Chetwynd's Visitor Centre, went over this year's numbers of travellers not only coming through Chetwynd but also stopping in and visiting our local Visitor Centre. Tyria was even able to give a break down of where those travellers were visiting from. Of the 5000+ visitors 50% were BC and local residents but the other 50% was made up of US and Mexican travelers as well as European and visitors from other areas of Canada. She also went over the other creative initiatives they have been working on including "Chetwynd Rocks" which were painted by students at Don Titus. Tyria showed Mayor and Council a message she received through social media saying that a "Chetwynd Rock" was found in Alaska and the traveller brought it to Mt. Fuji for someone else to find.

After Tyria's informative presentation Mayor and Council moved along to the third reading of bylaw 1081 that was discussed previously at the public hearing.

Mayor Courtoreille made the suggestion to Chief Administrative Officer Carol Newsom that he and Council should invest in some nice jackets with their District of Chetwynd logo to wear to events. Council decided that they would order jackets, not at tax payers expense but rather paid for personally by Mayor and Council, if they so choose.

The last important item up for discussion was the crosswalk by the highschool and how dangerous it seems to be. A letter was received where PAC Members from all the schools in Chetwynd have collaborated to create a louder voice that something needs to be done. Kids and young adults crossing the highway in front of Chetwynd's Public Library and the Rec Centre are feeling less and less confident with Chetwynd's drivers ability to pay attention to traffic lights. This lack of attention to the crosswalk traffic light has caused a large amount of near tragic instances. The Ministry of Transportation is in charge of the lights and has been contacted to come up with a better or different solution. Until a solution is found, and for the time being, Chetwynd's RCMP will be helping by periodically watching the area during high traffic crossing times and handing out heavy fines to violators of the traffic light.

The next Council meeting will take place on December 10th.




