CHAINSAW CARVING COMPETITION 2016







The Chetwynd International Chainsaw Carving Competition started out with some rainy weather but it didn't deter any of the carvers from creating 12 new incredible carvings to be displayed around town. Thankfully for the crowd, the weather improved over the course of the weekend, resulting in a beautiful Sunday afternoon to watch the quick carve competition, auction and awards. The carvers are only given 36 hours over the course of 3.5 days to take an enormous, raw log of wood and transform it into an astonishing piece of art, and the carvers did not disappoint. B.C. carver Ryan Cook created a heartfelt tribute to his father, a firefighter of 41 years, while others opted for animal life or fantastical depictions of mythological creatures like Medusa. The largest carving of the weekend belonged to Alaska's Jordan Anderson, who made a gigantic carving of Treebeard, a walking, talking tree creature from

WALK AND TALK THE PEACE

Stan Fraser gave a speech in Chetwynd on June 11 to signify the end of his journey, in which he walked a circuit from Chetwynd to Hudson's Hope, followed by Fort St. John and Dawson Creek before ending up back in Chetwynd. The purpose of the walk was to raise awareness of mental health, something he says people are often unwilling to discuss, and he wanted to make people feel more comfortable talking about issues before they become fatal. Fraser said he was inspired by his father, who suffers from depression and anxiety, and who didn't know how to handle it. "A parent has to be many things," Fraser said, "and men often have too much pride and don't seek out help or advice that they need." He went on to say "Men

are strong and tough, but we're also dumb," before recounting his experience in elementary school where he felt "tortured" by his teachers and came to hate school, turning to alcohol and drugs later in life to cope.

Fraser pointed out that people often feel shame when discussing matters of mental health and as a result he felt compelled to make this walk and help people feel alright talking about it, which he says is the first step to getting healthy. He brought up the high suicide rates among older men as well as his own head injury years ago, which left him in a coma for three days and a wheelchair for six months. The injury left him feeling angry all the time, something he says is common among sufferers of serious head injuries, and he became depressed for many years. He hopes this walk is only a stepping stone to greater things but hopes his message can reach more men, saying that during his entire walk he spoke to maybe three men. He stressed that when men don't talk about their mental health that it "hurts our wives and hurts our children," and that men should not fear these conversations.

Next year Fraser is planning a walk across all of Canada for the same reason, starting in April in Prince Rupert and travelling 6,792 km to reach Halifax over the course of seven months. His initial inspiration was Nelson Mandela's "Long Walk to Freedom" autobiography that was later turned into a movie, and Fraser decided he should try a long walk of his own. Asked whether he expects to deal with any difficult weather during his next walk, he laughed as said "we live in Canada, I was born in the north." He plans to take the big walk "one step at a time, because that's how we go through life," and hopes others will pick it up in the future in the event that he's unable to continue it. "I don't have the brains, but I have the legs," Fraser said, and it was clear to anyone watching him speak that he also has the heart.

CHAINSAW CARVING COMPETITION 2016





The event saw lots of vendors set up to sell their wares, both chainsaw-related and otherwise, as well as a range of concession items for the crowd to enjoy. Sunday's quick carve event saw the biggest crowd of the weekend, with lots of people wanting to get in on the auction that followed and bring home a piece to preserve the memories of the competition. Following the auction, awards were presented to the top 3 carvers as well as the Carver's Choice and People's Choice awards, with Mayor Nichols offering some thanks to people who travelled to Chetwynd for the competition, as well as all the event sponsors and volunteers. People's Choice went to Joerg Jung for his stunning moose carving that resembled a 3-D postcard showcasing the beauty of the Peace Region. Carver's Choice went to the UK's Tommy Craggs for his Medusa carving, Third Place went to Mike Winia for his Lion, and Second Place went to Jeff Samudosky for his Gargoyle. First Place went to Chad Danczyk, competing in Chetwynd for the first time this year, for his stunning Great Blue Heron carving. The carvings will be weather-treated and placed around town, and the competition will return next June to celebrate its 13th year.


