CARIBOU MEETING SUMMARY – MAY 22ND

Over 30 people attended the caribou meeting that occurred on Wednesday, May 22nd, as part of the Chetwynd Minerals North Conference. Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations & Rural Development representatives, Joelle Scheck, who is the Caribou Lead for the Northeast Region, and Hillary Morgan, who serves as Land & Resource Specialist for the Northeast Region, presented data on caribou populations in the province and provided details on the federal and provincial government's decision making process.

Scheck kicked off the presentation with a discussion of caribou populations in the province, stating that the southern mountain caribou population in the South Peace is currently around 220 animals, which is down from 800 animals in the early 2000s. She went on to talk about factors causing caribou decline, such as expansion and landscape disturbances, which she says are making caribou more vulnerable to predators.

Morgan then examined the Section 11 agreement, stating that its benefits include a collaborative approach to caribou recovery and access to

federal funding. She went on to say that the agreement seeks to provide information to stakeholders and Indigenous peoples concerned about caribou recovery efforts and possible socio-economic

impacts. Further details on the agreement, as well as how to provide feedback, can be found here: <https://engage.gov.bc.ca/caribou/>. Morgan also briefly discussed the first phase of herd plans, which can be found at gov.bc.ca/caribou.

Morgan went on to discuss potential approaches for herd plans, which include elements such as engagement with stakeholders and First Nations, impact analyses, science and traditional knowledge.

The session ended with a public question and answer period. During that segment, Jim Webb, Lands Department of West Moberly First Nations, expressed concern regarding a lack of input from First Nations.

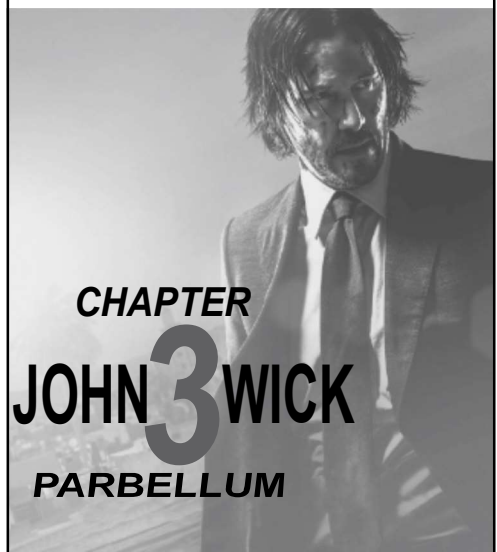

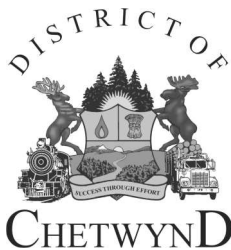
