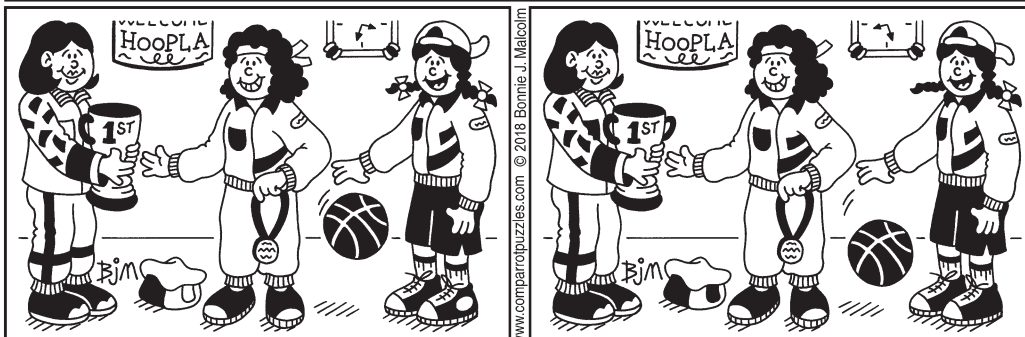

The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909,
2009 section 5.13: Obstruction of Motor Vehicles
No vehicle shall be left standing or parked:

- (i) in violation of this bylaw;
- (ii) in a position that causes it to interfere with firefighting;
- (iii) in a position that causes it to interfere with the normal flow of traffic on a highway; or

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

Winter is almost upon us and with it comes heavy snow falls. The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal will be removed without notice.

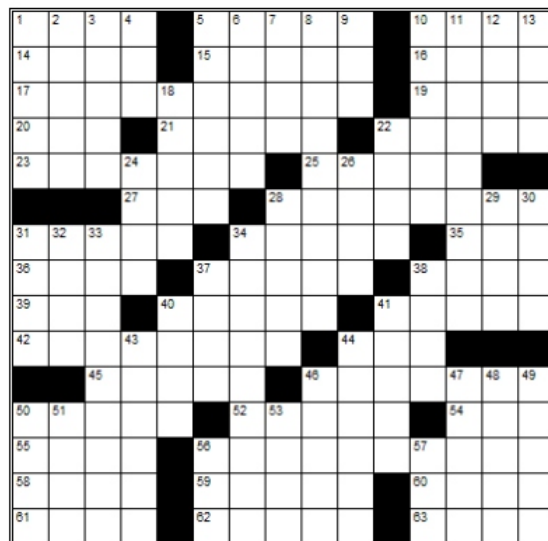

New Canada Pension Plan Changes To Enhance Your Retirement

In January 2019, the Canada Pension Plan (CPP) enhancement will take its first step toward improving retirement benefits for all working Canadians.
