CANADA'S MAJOR BANKS IN HOT WATER AFTER EMPLOYEES GO PUBLIC

News broke two weeks ago regarding a "frontline advisor" from TD banks that came forward to go public about the pressure and sales tactics used by TD banks to meet sales targets. Since then, over 1000 emails have been received by CBC, who came out with the story, that employees of the 5 biggest banks in Canada all have the same high pressure sales tactics.

BMO, CIBC, RBC, Scotia and TD were named in the emailed statements from employees and former employees of the banks, saying basically that these banks do not look out for their client's best interests, and often are pressured by whatever means necessary to accumulate more debt for their clients, in turn obviously bringing in more money for the corporate banks.

Many emails from these employees and former employees mentioned stress leave, medical leave, anxiety and depression from their jobs for trying to meet unrealistic sales targets. These 5 major banks were asked about an interview but they declined and ultimately sent statements saying that their employees are looking out for client's best interests but they are expected to follow codes of conduct. In the statements they did not address the excessive pressure to meet sales targets, the stress it causes employees and the exuberant amounts of money it's costing their clientele.

Td's stocks have dropped lower than they were in 2009 after this story broke, hopefully pressuring TD to right some wrongs and re-evaluate the way they do business, and we can assume the other banks will follow suit. All I can say is I haven't had an annoying phone call from any bank in over 2 weeks, pressuring me into a loan, a line of credit or another credit card.... it's kinda nice! 


