


What's Climate Got to Do With It?

"Preparing for climate change is necessary and possible" says climate scientist Trevor Murdoch from the Pacific Climate Impacts Consortium.

This past Monday, June 10th, Mr. Murdoch presented his thoughts on climate change to a room of Chetwynd residents at the Chetwynd and District Rec Centre. He was introduced by Cait Murphy, Program Coordinator from the Fraser Basin Council.

Trevor Murdoch went through weather statistics and trends spanning over the past 50 years and projected what the mid 21st century could potentially look like. The graph to the right shows rising temperatures in different situations.



- The yellow line of weather trends would be if the world

abided by the recommendations made at the Paris Summit in 2015.

- The red line, which indicates drastically rising temperature would be the norm, if the world continues at the rate it's going, producing the current amount of greenhouse gasses.

- And the blue line, Trevor says is very unlikely, but would be if the world made significant enough changes to reverse the effects of climate change.

We can basically expect to follow more so on the 'red' line, but hopefully more along the 'Yellow' path.


Mr. Murdock says our region, in the Northeast of the province, can expect more precipitation, longer hotter summers, shorter winters with less days below freezing and longer growing seasons. Although these all don't sound like awful things, and they aren't particularly bad for our region, change is imminent and preparing for it is important. There will be more frequent and severe heat waves, as well as growing wildfire risks, and an increase in extreme weather events.

By the year 2050, this region will have a very different climate, promoting different plant growth and different animals to inhabit the area. Don't expect to grow the same plants in your garden in 2050, or even see the same trees in the parks- Change will be gradual, but profound.

Regardless of whether the world is doing their part to help with climate change, there are always ways to personally help slow the effects of climate change, or at least prepare for different times ahead.

Mr. Murdock mentioned that his expertise is not "what you can do to prepare!" but more just "This is what to expect", but I personally have compiled a list of a few things you can do to help do your part: reduce water and

energy consumption, recycle as much as possible to help cut down on garbage sitting in landfills, cut down on vehicle use and idling vehicles, and grow

Don't wait until you hear that we've closed, it will be TOO LATE!






DESCRIPTION:

This perennial grows up to 1m tall with one single 2–5cm diameter flower with white petals and a yellow centre; lower leaves are spoon shaped and stalked; upper leaves are stalkless and narrower.

PREVENTION:

- Manage pastures to maintain healthy plant communities.
- Clean footwear, clothing, equipment, and tires after recreating or working in infested areas.
- MOW before the plant goes to flower.
- PURCHASEweed free hay, soil, seed mixes, and gravel.

Regional District.

These daisies are not native wildflowers in BC, they are invasive plants.



DESCRIPTION:

This annual or short-lived perennial grows up to 1m tall with multiple flowers, branched, glossy, fernlike leaves that alternate along the branched stem; seeds are viable once the flower is visible and are carried by wind, water, and animals.

PREVENTION:

- Clean equipment when working in infestations.
- MOW before plant goes to flower
- PURCHASEweed free hay, soil, seed mixes, and gravel.
