Council Meeting-February 3rd

This past Monday, The District of Chetwynd held the first council meeting of February in Council Chambers. Two Councillors, Disher and Wark, were absent from the meeting.

The meeting began with a presentation from Chris Larsen, President of the Chetwynd International Chainsaw Carving Championship Society. The new group has orchestrated the last 3 year's of championships and Chris mentioned this past year's turnout and championship was better than ever! With the help of sponsors, the carvers were given a higher appearance fee this past year, allowing them to cover the majority of travelling costs. The sponsorships and partnerships with local businesses and the District of Chetwynd has made the event extremely successful. Chris indicated that this year's events planning is well underway.



The next presentation was from Jennifer Baddeley, an EV researcher from Plug In BC. She came to council to chat about electric vehicles and their benefits. Jennifer was under the impression that the District of Chetwynd already had an EV charging station. She was unaware that the District had actually declined the offer in the last council meeting to put one in with the help of "Charge North". She went on to suggest that the District of Chetwynd purchase an electric vehicle as a fleet vehicle to "try it out". Councillor Mel Deck stated his opinion that he doesn't feel like the District should not be in charge of providing electric power, and that should be taken care of, and invested in, by a private sector. He also went on to quip that they would be interested in trying out an EV in the cold to see how well it would perform but would be looking into being given one as a tester.

The meeting moved along to Councilor reports where they discussed the Bc Natural Resource Forum that recently took place in Prince George. Councilor Weisgerber described the highlights of the forum and also mentioned that Mayor Courtoreille managed to engage in a quick conversation in a hotel lobby with Premier Horgan. Mayor Courtoreille went on to further discuss the situation, noting the recent letter that the PRRD received from Horgan, and his brief conversation about the caribou recovery issue with the Premier.

What I got from reading the letter is Premier Horgan is basically saying that the importance of the caribou recovery exceeds the effect it will have on the economy in Northern BC. The letter went on to say the provincial government plans to form several small groups to help voice the public's concerns, though the agreement itself will not be changed. BEWARE OF HIDDEN DANGERS ON THE JOB

Some jobs are just inherently dangerous to your health and safety, and some might put you at risk — but not for the reasons you may be thinking of.

Statistics show that if you currently work, or have worked, in the construction trade, you are significantly more likely than others to die from an opioid overdose.

Opioid-related deaths have increased significantly since 2003, with 1,474 reported in Ontario in 2018, according to Public Health Ontario. In the first six months of 2019, there were almost a thousand. Of those, 90 per cent were accidental, almost three-quarters of the victims were men, and half were between the ages of 25 and 44.

An unexpected risk factor is your occupation -- there is clearly a spike in opioid-related deaths among construction workers.

More research is needed to find out if there a connection between the physical nature of construction work and the range of pain-causing conditions or injuries it can cause. For example, are construction workers more likely to develop chronic pain or suffer painful complications from on-the-job injuries, get prescribed opioids, and then run into trouble from misusing them?

The available data don't offer clear-cut conclusions. But it's important for young adult men working in the trades to approach any use of opioids in pain management with care and caution





The District of Chetwynd is committed to keeping all our roads safe for all citizens and therefore any vehicles parked in a manner that interferes with effective snow removal may be removed. The Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw # 909, 2009 section 5.13:
Obstruction of Motor Vehicles
No vehicle shall be left standing or parked:

(iv) in a position that causes it to interfere with the construction, improvement, maintenance, alterations, extension, widening, marking, or repair of or snow removal from a highway.

As per the District of Chetwynd's Snow Clearing Policy, snow plowing will commence after 50mm of snow accumulation, roads will be plowed on a priority basis and residential streets will be plowed within 48 hours following the subsidence of the snowfall. If vehicles are parked on residential streets following a snow fall, the road will not be cleared until all vehicles have been removed and it has been deemed safe by the District.

HERBY SPRING CHICKEN POT PIE

Get in the spirit of Spring with this bright dish



PREP: 10 MINS
COOK: 30 MINS

INGREDIENTS

2 tbsp olive oil, plus a little extra for brushing over the pastry
bunch spring onions, sliced into 3cm pieces
250g frozen spinach
6 ready-cooked chicken thighs (or see tip, below)
350ml hot chicken stock
½ tbsp wholegrain mustard
200g frozen peas
200ml half-fat crème fraîche
½ small bunch tarragon, leaves finely chopped
small bunch parsley, finely chopped
270g pack filo pastry

INSTRUCTIONS

Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Heat the oil in a large, shallow casserole dish on a medium heat. Add the spring onions and fry for 3 mins, then stir through the frozen spinach and cook for 2 mins or until it's starting to wilt. Remove the skin from the chicken and discard. Shred the chicken off the bone and into the pan, and discard the bones. Stir through the stock and mustard. Bring to a simmer and cook, uncovered, for 5-10 mins.



Stir in the peas, crème fraîche and herbs, then remove from the heat. Scrunch the filo pastry sheets over the mixture, brush with a little oil and bake for 15-20 mins or until golden brown.
