## TRANS MOUNTAIN EXPANSION PROJECT INFORMATION RELEASED

Over half of the 1,100 km Trans Mountain Expansion Project has now been approved.

The pipeline expansion project, set to be undertaken by two Fort St John companies, hit 56 percent approval yesterday with the rest holding out for April hearings.

Along with the announcement of the hearings, the National Energy Board also released detailed route information of Segment 5 of the pipeline, which will run through the Peace Region.

The segment will run between Kamloops and Hope, with Fort St John based Surerus-Murphy being one of two companies set to build the first portion of the segment.

The project was approved by the government in 2016, but will need to satisfy all NEB pre-construction conditions before moving forward.

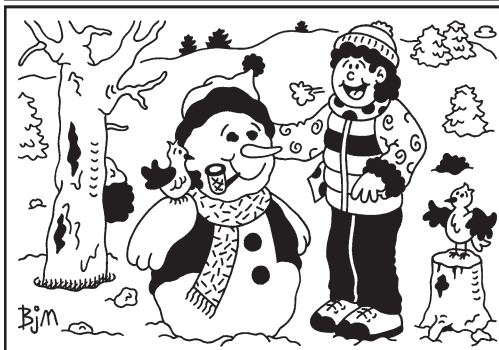

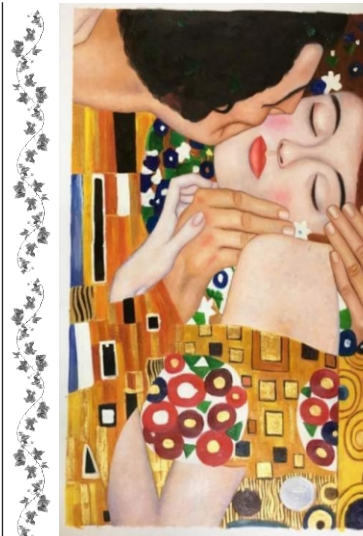

## FIRST NATIONS FIND NEW WAY TO PROTEST SITE C

West Moberly and Prophet River First Nations are showing Premier John Horgan just how serious they are when it comes to their beliefs regarding Site C.

The chiefs of the two groups, along with the Vice President of the Union of BC Chiefs, are set to return the proceeds and symbolic stakes from a campaign previously supported by the Premier.

In 2016 Horgan, then MLA, donated to the "Stakes in the Peace" fundraiser organized by the Peace Valley Environmental Association in protest of Site C's construction.

The stake sporting Horgan's name, along with those of two other NDP Ministers, was returned January 26th during a ceremony at BC legislature.

Along with the stakes, they will also be returning the 70 thousand dollars donated during the 2016 campaign.

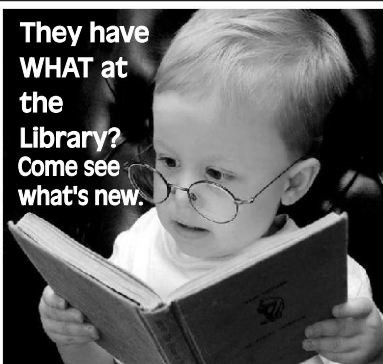

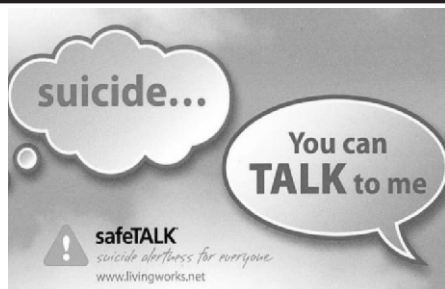

safeTALK, about three hours in duration, is a training that prepares anyone over the age of 15 to identify persons with thoughts of suicide and connect them to suicide first aid resources.

This program alerts community members to signs that a person may

be considering suicide. It acknowledges that while most people at risk of suicide signal their distress and invite help, these intervention opportunities are often overlooked. Participants learn to recognize when someone may have thoughts of suicide and to respond in ways that link them with further suicide intervention help.

It is intended that safeTALK participants will be better prepared to:

- recognize that invitations to help are often overlooked;
- move beyond common tendencies to miss, dismiss and avoid suicide;
- notice and respond to situations in which thoughts of suicide may be present;
- apply basic TALK steps (Tell, Ask, Listen, and KeepSafe); and
- connect the person with thoughts of suicide to suicide first aid help and further community resources.
