COUNCIL MEETING

On Monday, October 16th, there was a regular council meeting held at the District Office's Council Chambers. The mayor, all council members and administrative staff were in attendance.

The meeting began with Tyria Plamondon of the Chetwynd Visitor Centre with a service report for the 2017 spring and summer. Tyria began by mentioning everything the visitor centre has been offering including free bike rentals, free sports equipment rentals like rackets balls fishing rods, and more. The visitor centre also has consignment sales and souvenirs for visitors, and of course a wealth of information about Chetwynd. Their revenue this year well exceeded their expectations, bringing in over \$19,000. Visitation numbers are up since last year and way up since 2015, which Tyria explained was probably due to Canada 150 and the 75th anniversary of the Alaska Highway. She mentioned that the Visitor Centre will be part of the District Office from October until March 2018, to allow the Chetwynd Community Arts Council to operate from their location throughout the winter months.

The next presentation was from Glenda Farnden and Greg Smith of STARS (Shock Trauma Air Rescue Service). Glenda began their presentation by thanking Chetwynd for their united effort to maintain this service. STARS works in collaboration with BCEHS (BC Emergency Health Services) to transport patients in remote locations quickly and efficiently to health care facilities. The have leading edge technology onboard their helicopters with extensively trained EMTs and ample equipment to handle the toughest situations. Since 2007, STARS has responded to 17 calls from Chetwynd and another 4 from areas directly surrounding Chetwynd.

no.1060,2017 and the adoption of the tax exemption bylaw no.1061,2017.



Fat free food and gluten free foods can contain up to 40% more calories and 10% more sugar. - 5. Instant Oatmeal If you buy the authentic cooking oatmeal in bulk, this doesn't pertain to you, but if you're a fan of peaches and cream, or maple and brown sugar, you aren't doing your body any favours. The amount of sodium alone in one package is absurd, and then you look at the sugar, yikes!
- 6. Protein Bars These are basically as healthy as shovelling a Mr. Big in your face, with a miniscule amount of protein so that they aren't blatantly lying to you.
- 7. Frozen Yogurt We all hope that eating frozen yogurt over ice cream is making a smart decision, but they are basically the same. There is almost no difference in the amount of sugar in both.
- 8. Microwave Popcorn- Microwave popcorn seems like it would be simply kernels and butter, in reality it contains high amounts of preservatives and additives.
- 9. Smoothies If you make your own at home this doesn't apply to you, but if you're lining up out the door for a smoothie bought from a franchise (not naming any names), chances are there is enough sugar for 3 cups of coffee in your cup of "fruit" smoothie.
- 10. Veggie Chips Potato is a veggie, too... it doesn't matter what kind you're having, it has been fried. Baked veggie chips do exist, you just have to read the label to eliminate the phonies.

I'm not preaching to anyone to not eat your favourite foods, because Lord knows that won't stop me from enjoying frozen yogurt or tortillas! This is just more of a reminder that even if the label reads "all natural" or fat free, chances are it's just as unhealthy as the substitute. It seems the only way to know what you're truly eating is to make everything yourself!


