## MP ZIMMER PLEASED WITH STANDING COMMITTEE ON JUSTICE AND HUMAN RIGHTS DECISION

Bob Zimmer, Member of Parliament for Prince George-Peace River-Northern Rockies and Chair of the National Prayer Breakfast is extremely pleased that the Standing Committee on Justice and Human Rights has accepted the amendment proposed by Conservative Shadow Minister Rob Nicholson.

Liberal Justice Minister Jody Wilson-Raybould introduced Bill C-51 which included a clause that would remove section 176 from the Criminal Code, a section that provides specific protection for clergy and anyone taking part in religious services.

"We are hearing more and more about specific attacks based on religion and this is definitely not the time to be reducing protections, if anything we should be doing all we can to ensure that these acts of violence are punished more severely," said Mr. Zimmer. "I'm very pleased that this committee was able to work together, to listen to the witnesses and the evidence that was presented, and to ultimately make the right decision."

### BC Rural Dividend program announces fourth intake

Applications for funding in the fourth intake of the BC Rural Dividend program will be accepted Nov. 15 to Dec. 15, 2017, Minister of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development Doug Donaldson announced today.

"I encourage local governments, not-for-profit organizations and First Nations to get their applications submitted," said Donaldson. "We're committed to action that will strengthen rural economies and provide jobs in rural communities."

Single applicants can apply for up to \$100,000 for community-driven projects and must contribute at least 20% of the total project cost. Partnerships, involving more than one eligible applicant, can apply for up to \$500,000 and must contribute 40% of the total project cost.

A project-development funding stream will provide up to \$10,000 to help communities with limited capacity build the business cases and feasibility assessments needed to develop strong projects and support the development of future project applications.

Under the BC Rural Dividend program's special circumstances allowance, which is used to help rural communities facing economic hardship, funding will also support those communities hard hit by wildfires in 2017.

Projects will be assessed and approved based on the following criteria:

- Rural communities most in need
- Improved community resiliency and economic strength
- Partnership building and enhanced shared prosperity
- Project feasibility and sustainability
- Economic impact on rural communities
- Attracting and retaining youth
- Innovation in economic development





"It's very unfortunate but also very apparent that the Liberal Members who rose to debate this Bill didn't actually read it nor do they understand current Canadian firearms laws. This Bill would not have made any changes to the rigorous process of background checks that are required to get a

not have been any easier to obtain a firearm in Canada.

"Bill C-346 would have eliminated some of the duplication that currently exists as a result of the RCMP's Continuous Eligibility program. The information is already being updated every 24 hours through this program which makes the 10 year update that this Bill proposed entirely rational.

"I firmly believe that 'Grandpa Joe' and any other law-abiding firearms owner should never be in danger of a five year prison sentence as a result of processing delays.

### **B.C.'S STABLE ECONOMY PAYS DIVIDENDS**

Statistics Canada confirms British Columbia's economy grew by 3.5% in 2016, exceeding last February's forecast of 2.7% provided by the Economic Forecast Council (EFC).

The province's higher-than-expected economic growth in 2016 triggers the Economic Stability Dividend (ESD), negotiated as part of the province's 2014 Economic Stability Mandate. The ESD will increase compensation for unionized employees by 0.4% beginning in Feb. 2018.

"The Economic Stability Dividend helps to share the benefits of B.C.'s growing economy with employees in K-12 education, post-secondary, research universities, health care, Crown corporations, public service and community social services," said Minister of Finance Carole James. "Our government will continue to ensure that the benefits of economic growth are shared widely by taking action to make life more affordable, improve the services that people rely on, and invest in a strong, sustainable economy."

To activate the ESD, the GDP growth for British Columbia must exceed the forecast provided by the independent EFC for the fiscal year. The wage increase is calculated based on 50% of the positive difference between the EFC forecast for GDP growth and Statistics Canada's data. This is the third of four potential dividends.

The province remains on track to be one of Canada's strongest economies in 2017 and 2018 as most private sector economists, banks and economic think-tanks are forecasting that British Columbia will continue to record real GDP growth that ranks among the best in Canada.





Statement on immigration and refugee legal aid services

Attorney General David Eby has issued the following statement:

"I would like to thank the federal government, and Justice Minister Jody Wilson Raybould in particular, for committing to provide British Columbia with additional funding to ensure refugees in our province can continue to access legal aid services for the remainder of this fiscal year.

"The federal Department of Justice has committed an additional \$368,880 to allow the province's Legal Services Society (LSS) to maintain services for immigrants and refugees in need of legal aid to March 31, 2018. This is in addition to \$580,101 in onetime funding provided earlier this year by the Department of Justice, and adds to the LSS base budget of \$1.9 million provided jointly by the Province and federal government each year.

"As an open, diverse and welcoming place, British Columbia is experiencing a significant increase in demand for legal aid from refugees fleeing war, oppression and persecution. We appreciate the recognition of this pressure by the federal government and its help to ensure that we can maintain legal aid services for these vulnerable individuals and families.

"I look forward to continuing to work with our federal counterparts on our shared commitment to a justice system that works for all British Columbians.'
