## MORE HIGHLIGHTS

- Southbridge’s elementary after school program, **All In!**, is up and running! Fifty-five students from West Street and Charlton Street schools in grades 2-5 participate in free, after-school academic and enrichment activities, Monday through Friday, from 3:00-5:30 PM at West Street School. The program launched in November as a partnership between Southbridge Public Schools and the Southbridge Recreation Department, Our Bright Future Inc., Southbridge Community Connections, YMCA, and YOU Inc. Each community partner organizes activities one day a week, from sports clinics, service learning, STEM workshops, and community-building. Middle and high school students participate in the program as mentors and facilitators of team-building activities throughout the week. Family workshops will also be offered beginning in March. This program has been an incredible example of strong community partnership that we hope to expand next year to serve more Southbridge students.
- **Prom Closet**, a low-cost/swap shop for prom wear, is coming soon! Donations of prom, formal or bridesmaid dresses, shoes, and tuxedos are now being accepted at the high school main office or Jacob Edwards Library.
