When you draw DOWN strokes, say:



say "DRAW DOWN"

When you move BACK UP to the top of the page, say:

say "HOP to the TOP"

For a ROUNDED line, say:



say "DRAW a SMALL BUMP"

"DRAW a BIG BUMP"

For a HORIZONTAL line, say:



say "WALK along the FLOOR"

For a DIAGONAL line, say:



say "SLIDE DOWN"
