The *Finish Line Scholarship*, sponsored by Adam and Tricia Borton, is offered to long-time students who are now approaching graduation. Applicants are challenged to share in an essay how they've overcome three obstacles on their path to completing their degrees.

Wayne first enrolled at NAU in 2012. He later earned his Bachelor's degree and is now pursuing his Master's degree.

"I've faced many adverse situations in pursuit of my degrees," said Wayne, who juggled military service, competing job, training and family obligations, and a health scare involving his mother that required round-the-clock caregiving to assist in her rehabilitation and recovery.

In the spirit of the Finish Line Scholarship, Wayne persevered, earned his bachelor's degree in nursing and is now pursuing his master's degree in nursing with just 18 credits to go.

Adam and Tricia appreciate the challenge of juggling college with life's obligations. Adam earned his first NAU degree, a Bachelor's in International Business, nearly 10 years after he first enrolled due to multiple deployments while serving in the United States Air Force. He recently completed his master's degree at NAU.

"Tricia and I created this scholarship to help support students who have stayed the course and are now realizing their goals of achieving a college degree," said Adam.
