But, there is a really cool event in June that just might be the impetus to get your readers on the road -- the 26th annual [Festival Flamenco Internacional de Alburquerque](#) presented by The National Institute of Flamenco. The event takes place June 10-16, 2013 at the National Hispanic Cultural Center on the University of New Mexico's Albuquerque campus.

This week-long celebration is distinguished as the most important and longest standing flamenco dance event outside of Spain, making Albuquerque the center for flamenco in the United States. The romantic lure of flamenco draws more than 5500 artists and visitors each year from across the globe who come to see performances by, and take classes from, some of the most highly revered flamenco artists in the world including Ivan Vargas, Karima Amaya and Marco Flores.

During the festival, master artists teach more than 30 dance, guitar and singing workshops for beginners, professionals and everyone in between interested in learning about this powerful and sultry art form. Each night at 8:00 p.m., spectators can enjoy spectacular performances by world-class performers.
