## Forum Rules

2. A candidate may not participate in the Forum unless at least one general election opponent also participates
3. Your participation in this forum constitutes acknowledgement you cannot use, rebroadcast or print Forum content without permission of the League of Women Voters.
4. No audience photographs or recordings during the Forum.
5. This is a Forum, not a debate.
6. The candidates will remain behind the table.
7. The candidate may stand or remain seated when answering the question or making a statement.
8. Each candidate must answer the question posed but may choose to use a portion of the allocated time to respond to a previous question.
9. The first responder to each question and the closing statement will rotate based on a predetermined League generated random speaking sequence.
10. Each candidate will be allowed:
  - a. One minute to answer each question.
  - b. One minute for a closing statement.Out of consideration for time and to allow more questions, we did not allow for opening statements.
11. The timekeeper will hold up a sign when 30 seconds remain.
12. A bell will ring when your time is up; please end the sentence and stop speaking.
13. There will be no time allotted for rebuttals.
14. The audience will please refrain from applauding or in other ways demonstrating support or non-support for a candidate.
15. Displays of campaign paraphernalia, buttons, t-shirts, signs, or anything that supports a particular candidate are not permitted in the auditorium.
16. The moderator may repeat the question.
17. The candidates will not interrupt one another and refrain from personal attacks.
18. Questions for the candidates from the audience and the League of Women Voters are written on League-supplied 3x5 cards and handed to the question screening team. You can receive cards from and pass your questions to our volunteers.
