It's supposed to be really hot this week so make sure you remember how to be safe in the sun - maybe you could create a poster if you want an extra challenge



As per last week - you can do these tasks in any order - or at any time that suits you - but in case you are worried about how to arrange your day - it could look something like this:

Task	1 hour
Reading eggs, spelling shed or sumdog	30 mins
Reading	20 mins

Not necessarily in that order and make sure to take breaks - don't do it all at once!

At school we are trying to learn the letter names (the alphabet song letters) and know which one goes with each sound. It's quite tricky because most of them sound very different to their sound! Watch this episode of alpha blocks and then throughout the week have a go at spelling out simple words using the letter names instead of the letter sounds. Simple words could be cat, dog, mat, tin etc.

Friday	Task 4	Spelling shed - spelling words	Read to an adult
