UNITE

We aim to unite the culture within the Temple and North Philadelphia community by providing tools for students to better understand both communities.

Fostering Relationships

- Push for a voting seat on the Board of Trustees
- Defend against construction that disproportionately affects the surrounding community

Transparency

- Raise awareness of the departments and support systems in the university that provide services for students
- Improve communication for students based on previous feedback and continuing to survey students

Inclusion

- Directly address hate-speech and bias-related incidents that occur on and off campus
- Expand and highlight resources for survivors of sexual violence
- Create a relationship with the Early Childhood-Elementary Education (PreK-4) Department for more attainable child care services available on or near campus
- Require construction pathway regulations that support the agency and mobility of persons with disabilities
- Expand and advance resources for LGBTQIA+ identifying students
 - Push to allow students to have their preferred name printed on their OWL cards from the start of matriculation
 - Capitalize on a campus partnership with the Mazzoni Center to further health services and social resources

- Advocate for a more comprehensive orientation by offering more opportunities for international students to work with faculty to form an agenda for orientation
- Provide opportunities to transfer students to get involved on campus by promoting Temple Fest between semesters
- Audit Temple's transit bus system and advocate for a system that provides better options for transportation between campuses
- Implement intentional focus groups to gauge student experiences for faculty diversity training

GROW

We intend to grow on Temple's foundation by improving our use of space, sustainable practices, Temple Student Government, and expanding our resources.

Smart Use of Space

- Work with Temple's administration to improve communication and transparency with the on and off campus developments
- Expand resources and allocate spaces to assist students in crisis situations
- Create an ADA (American Disability Act) accessible campus during construction

Sustainability

- Audit our recycling and compost systems, and raise awareness of green options
- Push for more LEED (Leadership Environmental and Energy Design) Certifications throughout campus

Temple Student Government

- Strengthen Parliament's student outreach, transparency, and establish a Communications team
 - The Communications Team will consist of a Director of Communications, Deputy Director of Communications, and Promotions Manager.
- Reform Ethics Board to increase accountability and establish checks and balances
- Re-establish responsibilities of the Communications Team
- Implement a free-speech component in TSG meetings for students to voice their ideas
- Add a Questions and Concerns section on the TSG website

Expand Resources

- Build relationships with institutions for academic and professional development

ADVOCATE

We will advocate for students to Temple's administration to provide more resources for campus safety, housing, and mental health.

Campus Safety

- Audit the accessibility and safety of our campus with the ADA task force
- Implement active shooter drills to keep administrators and students aware of the latest procedures
- Work with Campus Safety to increase awareness on student resources regarding security

Housing

- Lobby for various housing options that represent students of all economic backgrounds
- Promote off campus services and encourage landlord responsibility and accountability

Mental Health

- Increase promotion and advocacy for mental health services
- Work with TAUP (Temple Association of University Professionals) in implementing procedures for faculty to recognize and support students impacted by crisis situations
- Expand resources and allocate spaces to assist students in crisis situations
