“WREATH MAKING WORKSHOP”

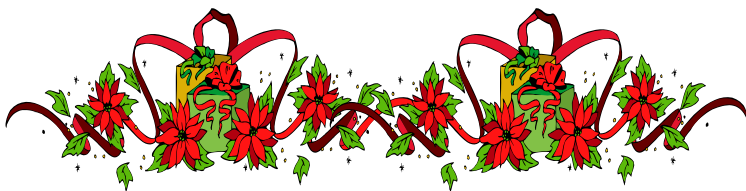
