HEALTH & SAFETY COMMITTEE REFRESHER COURSE

Aims

- 1. To refresh Health & Safety Committee members on their role as committee members, and the role of their Health & Safety Committee under the WHS Act 2011.**
- 2. To refresh Health & Safety Committee members on how to have an effective committee and how to identify and resolve problems that are reducing the effectiveness of their HSC.**

Objectives

1. On completion of this course, participants should be able to;
 - a) explain their role as members and the role of their HSC in regards to consultation in their workplace,
 - b) explain what needs to be done for their HSC to be more effective.
2. During the course participants will;
 - a) review the effectiveness of the operation of their committee, so that areas where improvements can be made can be addressed,
 - b) evaluate the effectiveness of the management system in their workplace and identify and prioritise those areas which should receive the committee's attention,
 - c) develop recommendations that will enable their committee to deal with problems in the working of their committee and the way in which WHS issues are addressed.

This course is practical and places an emphasis on the active participation of all course participants. The course is designed for both representatives of the PCBU and workers, including HSRs whom are also committee members.

Prerequisites

Participants are recommended to have completed a course of training for new HSC members under the WHS Act 2011 prior to doing this refresher training.
