Entry is open to any fencer aged 13 or over on 1st January 2018

Handicap categories:

- +2 Fencers with less than 1 year of fencing experience
- +1 Fencers with 1 to 2 years of fencing experience
- +1 Fencers in their first competition OR over 60 on 01/01/2018 (can't claim for both)
- +1 Female fencers
- -1 Fencers with National Ranking points OR in the top 30% of the SW Regional Ranking
- -2 Fencers in the top 50% of the National Ranking OR top 10% of the SW Regional Ranking Whichever Rankings-based handicap is the larger will be applied, based on the editions published in early October 2018 (i.e. including competitions to the end of September).

Medals will be awarded to the top four, the best Veteran (over 40 on 01/01/2018), and the Best Man or Best Lady (whichever is not the overall winner). The overall winner will also receive a £25 Salago voucher.

If there are 17 or fewer entries, the competition will run as a Poule Unique. If there are 18 or more entries, one round of poules will be followed by a full DE tableau (to 15 hits, handicap multiplied by 3).

Current membership of British Fencing at Compete or Recreational level is required. Fencers must use at least 800N plastrons and 350N jackets and breeches.
