



2019 CENTRAL REGION RALLY GENERAL INFORMATION

Please retain these rally information pages for your future reference

This information is being sent to you to help make the registration process fairly simple and as informative as possible. You may duplicate the Registration Form prior to completing it and share with other families. It can also be downloaded from the Central Region webpage on the NAARVA website at WWW.NAARVA.COM.

Do not mail any registration after June 7, 2019, as any registrations postmarked after June 7, 2019, will be charged a late fee of \$50.00. On-site gate registrations will be charged an additional \$50.00 fee above and beyond the regular registration fee with cash, cashier check or money order being the only acceptable methods of payment.

Acceptable forms of payment: Payment must be made in full by check or money order. Do not send cash. All returned checks will be assessed a fee of \$35.00 and a \$15.00 administrative fee above and beyond the registration fee. Payment after June 7, 2019 must be paid in full by cashier check or money order.

Parking: RV's will be parked on Sunday, June 23rd **beginning at 2:00 p.m.** Beginning on Monday, June 24th through Wednesday, June 26th, parking will be from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Anyone arriving on Thursday or later, should ask the RV office to contact the Parking team to be parked. Those arriving after 6:00 p.m. on any day, will have to park AT THE CASINO IN THEIR LOT, AS THERE IS NOT A "HOLDING AREA WITHIN THE PARK." THE GRAND CASINO IS LOCATED NEXT TO THE RV PARK, WHICH DOES NOT HAVE ANY HOOK-UPS. The parking team will park you after 9:00 a.m. the next morning. Please do not attempt to park yourself.

Chapters and groups that want to park together *must* send in their registration forms in the same envelope. For the informal groups that want to park together please assign your group a unique name (i.e. Traveling Wonders, etc.) on your registration form. Every attempt will be made to have your group parked together, but it is NOT guaranteed (depending on the size of the group).

Early Bird Parking: If you wish to arrive before Sunday, June 23rd, please designate this on your registration form. The rate for the extra day(s) parking is \$40 per day. If you arrive before your assigned day, there is the possibility that your site may be occupied.

Handicap Parking: The RV Resort only has six (6) handicapped sites which are located close to the bathhouse. Individuals who request handicap parking will be assigned a site on a first come, first served basis, according to registration date received. Please send a copy of your doctor's certificate or a copy of both sides of your rear view mirror handicap placard with your registration form. If you would like one of these sites please check the appropriate box on your registration form.

Campsites: One hundred sixty (160) full 50 amp hook-up sites have been reserved for the rally. All sites are on a back-in tar pad with shuttle service running every 10-20 minutes to the casino and event center. All sites are also equipped with cable TV, fire pits, picnic tables and 24-hour security (each site will be given a "Gated card entry key" once the guest has checked in and been assigned to a site).

Buildings: All activities held at the Event Center are in air conditioned rooms.

Planned Events

Auction: Each chapter/group is asked to furnish one (1) gift item valued at \$25 or more. Items are to be gift bagged or wrapped in newspaper. Individuals may also donate items. Bring your gifts to the Event Center on Saturday from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. *Remember that if your gift item does not appear to be worth \$25.00, then the person winning the auction for this gift has a right to ask for a refund. WE DON'T WANT TO HAVE THIS HAPPEN!*

Bean Bag Baseball Tournament: Each chapter or group will be asked to participate as a team in this tournament. The preliminary rounds will be held on Monday, June 24th with the final rounds taking place on Thursday, June 27th. Each team will need to have a minimum of 7 people. Please let your Chapter President or group leader know whether or not you wish to be part of the team. Until then, get your "pitching arm" warmed up.

Bid Whist Tournament: Brush up on your card playing skills and join your fellow campers at an old-fashioned bid whist tournament on Wednesday from 2:00 – 4:00 p.m. and Friday from 4:00 – 6:00 PM in the Event Center.

Cake Walk: Each chapter is asked to furnish three cakes or sealed baked goods. Bring your items to the Registration Room at the RV Resort Office on Thursday from 1:00 to 1:30 p.m. Be sure to stay to enjoy the cake walk which starts at 1:30 p.m.

Card Bingo: Come enjoy this exciting and fast paced game on Monday and Tuesday night. There will be a \$.25 fee collected for each game.

Gospel Reception: Rev. Theodore (Ted) Fox and Evangelist Jacqueline Fox will Host our Sunday evening worship services. They are from "Walking By Faith Apostolic Ministries," which is a local church in Hinckley. Come out and hear them and fellowship with other members from their church. We will also have other activities presented on Sunday night to start off your experience in Hinckley, Minnesota.

Saturday Worship Services: Our "closing worship services" will once again be hosted by Rev. Fox with a special "Guest Minister, Rev. Dr. Earl F. Miller" from Progressive Baptist Church in Minneapolis, providing the sermon and closing remarks. Central Region's own Rev. Milton Clayton will also be part of the program.

Horseshoe Tournament: The tournament is scheduled to take place on Tuesday, June 25th. Please designate on the second page of the registration form if you wish to participate in this event.

Meals: There are two meals planned. A Plated Breakfast complete with French toast, seasonal fruit and country sausage on Thursday morning and a dinner on Saturday night.

Central Region Yard Sale: Once again, we will have this event (since it was such a success last year!). This event will take place for several hours on Saturday, June 29th. So, start gathering the items you want to offer for sale and place them on display in front of your site. Both new and gently used items are acceptable.

50/50 Raffle: We will once again sell tickets for our 50/50 Raffle. Buy a chance to receive some "extra cash." Drawing will be held on Saturday night. Remember, you can't win if you don't play!

Other Planned Activities: In addition to all of the activities listed above, many plans are in place to ensure that you have every opportunity to participate in activities that will provide new information, skills for safety and future planning for your personal security. Seminars may include: health, RV maintenance and technical information, road safety, and fire safety. Also included will be a Night Bike Ride, Meet and Greet, and a special "Night at the Races." Classes include:

- **T-Shirt Braiding** – Bring: T-shirt (larger than you normally wear), needle and thread, scissors, and masking tape.

- Swedish Weaving – Beginners – Bring ½ yard of Monks Cloth, 1 skein of yarn, and a weaving needle.
- Intermediate and Advanced – Bring your own supplies of what you are working on.
