GENERAL INFORMATION

Please retain these rally information pages for your future reference.

This information is being sent to you to help make the registration process as informative as possible. We recommend that you copy the Registration Form prior to completing it and share it with other families. In addition, after completing your registration please keep a completed copy for your records. It can also be downloaded from the NAARVA website at www.naarva.com.

Mesa, Arizona is the third-largest city in Arizona, and thriving. Current population is over 500,000 and growing. Incorporated in 1883, Mesa has seen a lot of history in the East Valley and that history is lovingly preserved in historic neighborhoods, several museums and a quaint downtown area. Next to the old is a lot of new, too. The Mesa Arts Center in the heart of downtown is a hub of activity and entertainment.

All registrations postmarked after **June 14, 2019**, will be charged a late fee of \$25.00. Please do not mail any registration forms after June 28, 2019.

Acceptable forms of payment: Payment must be made in full by check, money order or Pay Pal. Please do not send cash. All returned checks will be assessed a fee of \$50.00 above the registration fee.

On-site gate registrations: These registrants will be charged an additional \$50.00 fee above the regular registration fee. Cash or check will be the acceptable method of payment for on-site registration.

Camp Day Pass: Rate for day pass is \$25.00 per day, per person.

Cancellation Policy: All cancellations must adhere to the following criteria:

- 1) Must be requested in writing.
- 2) Must be postmarked no later than June 14, 2019

All approved cancellations will have a \$50.00 administrative fee deducted **and any meal/site/tour cost that cannot be cancelled will also be deducted.** Any cancellation requests received after June 14 must be approved by the NAARVA Executive Board. **Please note any refund request received after July 24, 2019 will not be refunded.**

Parking: RV's will be parked starting from Sunday, July 21 to Thursday, July 25 from 8am to 5pm. **Those arriving after 5pm will be parked by Resort Staff.** You will not be able to park yourself without a Resort Representative and/or NAARVA Parking Team volunteer. Please follow the Team directions.

Early Bird Arrival Parking: If you wish to arrive between Friday, July 19 and Saturday, July 20 please **remember if you want to park together, you must arrive together!** Parking together is not always possible when considerations must be made for size of recreational vehicles and/or handicap site. Parking with your **Thousand Trails Membership or other discounted rates (AAA, Good Sam, etc.) will not apply during the NAARVA Rally dates which includes July 19, 2019 – July 28, 2019.**

Resort sites: Mesa Spirit RV Resort has over 1,800 sites. The sites can accommodate Trailers, 5th Wheels, Class A, Class B and Class C recreational vehicles all of which are fully contained and up to 75 feet in length. Mesa Spirit does not allow pop-ups or tenting. All guests will be assigned their site by the Rally Team. Amenities include, all full hook ups, free Wi-Fi internet, laundry, 8-heated pools and spas, fitness center, 13 pool tables, 12 horseshoe courts, card room, 9-hole miniature golf course and much more.

Handicap Parking: These sites are the closest to where the rally activities are being planned, but if you have mobility issues, please bring your own form of personal transportation or rent a golf cart because vehicle parking may be very limited around some of the buildings. When requesting a handicap parking on your registration form, please note that you will not be parked with your chapter or group. You are encouraged to visit the Rally Site website at www.mesaspirit.com.

Badges: For your safety, security and access to all Rally Activities. Your badge will be used to determine that you are registered to participate in seminars, meetings, etc. All youth, young adults and mature adults must wear your badges.
