THREE CATEGORIES (Open to all Australian residents)

- Shire of Mundaring National Young Writers Awards (10 to 17 years) (for Australian residents/citizens)
- Bendigo Bank Mundaring Open Awards (18+ years) (for Australian residents/citizens)
- Annette Cameron Award for an Unpublished Poet (for current WA residents only)

LINE LIMITS: Youth: Maximum 50. Open: Maximum 50. Annette Cameron: Maximum 50.

ENTRY FEES: Youth: FREE. Open: 1 entry \$10.00; 2 entries \$15.00; 3 entries \$20.00

PRIZES (*subject to Judge's discretion*):

- Bendigo Bank Mundaring Open Awards: 1st \$300 plus one weekend residency at the KSP Writers' Centre with a two year expiry, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$75, up to five commended – certificate only
- Bendigo Bank Mundaring Youth Awards: 1st \$150, 2nd \$50, up to five commended – certificate only
- Mundaring National Young Writers Encouragement Award (14 and under): \$25
- Annette Cameron Award for an Unpublished Poet: 1st \$100, up to three commended – certificate only

Conditions of Entry

- Open and youth awards: Open to Australian residents and citizens only.
- Annette Cameron Award: Open to current WA residents only.
- Work to be original, unpublished (anything that has appeared in the public arena, including self-publishing and social media, is considered published) either in print or online, not have received an award in another competition, and not under consideration elsewhere from the time of entry in these awards until the official announcement of winners.
- Limit of three entries per author, per category.
- Individual entries cannot be entered in more than one section.
- Entries to be submitted as per instructions on the KSP Writers' Centre competitions webpage (see 'How to Submit'): <https://www.kspwriterscentre.com/short-fiction-competition>
- To ensure anonymity NO WRITERS' NAMES TO APPEAR ON ENTRY OR COVER SHEET.
- Entry will not be returned and will be destroyed after the competition, so keep a copy of your work.
- The KSP Competitions Secretary and KSP Board of Management are not eligible to enter.
- Award placements are issued only by discretion of the judge in the event of a worthy winning entry. The judges' decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The KSP Foundation Inc. reserves the right to publish the winning entry or entries online or in a publication related to KSP should the opportunity occur, in consultation with the author.
- Entries which do not reflect the stated conditions as outlined on the KSP Writers' Centre competitions webpage (see 'How to Submit'), which are not accompanied by a fully filled Entry Form or are postmarked later than the deadline may be disqualified and the fee/s forfeited.
