Consultation and Engagement February & March 2017

- Leaflets and Questionnaire (paper and online)

Responses:

416 questionnaire responses 50% from the TA1 postcode 47% over 65 vs. 7% under 34...

- 65% Agreed that improvements needed for pedestrians and cyclists
- 75% Agreed that improvements needed to public spaces
- 59% Agreed that traffic restrictions would improve road safety



Responses:

- 47% Agreed restrictions would boost the economy
- 43% would stay longer in Town Centre

Concerns over:

- Congestion on other routes
- User conflict (pedestrians, cyclists and buses)
- Access to on street parking
- Reduced accessibility for those with restricted mobility
- Must link with improvements to car parks – Variable, dynamic signage



Next Steps

- Strong Political and Officer Support to proceed with trial, broad public support
- Finer details of trial being developed TRO's, junction improvements, signage etc.
- O Launch of trial scheme to public end of 2017
- Implementation of trial Spring 2018
- O 6 month reviews room for improvement
- Defining 'success' footfall, economy, environment etc.
- Development of funding package for permanent scheme
