KHS 2017 SHOW SCHEDULE

SECTION A: Vegetables

Exhibits MUST be clean and labelled

Beetroot

1. 3 with 8cms tops, any variety (do not cut in half)

Carrots

2. 3 with 8cms tops, any variety

Onions

3. 3 bulbs not to exceed 250 grams, with 5cms neatly tied stalk
4. 1 bulb largest by weight

Shallots

5. 10 not to exceed 3cms in diameter (neatly tied 5cms stalk)

Potatoes

6. 5 White - medium sized, avoid blemishes
7. 5 Other than white – as above

Beans

8. Runner - 7 with stalks
9. French, climbing or dwarf - 7 with stalks

Courgettes

10. 3 young, uniform with some stalk, any variety

Tomatoes – all with calyx

11. 8 small fruits, 3.5cms or smaller, any variety
12. 5 fruits, larger than 3.5cms, any variety
13. Single stem truss with at least 5 ripe fruits

Miscellaneous

14. 1 bizarre, ugly or misshapen vegetable/fruit.
15. Longest runner bean

Any other vegetable

16. not listed above –minimum of 3, maximum 5

K.H.S Top Tray

17. Max display area 45 x 60cms, only garnish parsley. **No** plates, sand or onion rings allowed. 3 groups of vegetable from following:

3 carrots.. 6 potatoes. 6 chillies. 6 pods of peas or mangetouts. 3 pakchoi.. 3 onions. 3 beetroot. 6 tomatoes. 3 peppers. 6 beans of 1 variety

Herbs – judged for Quality

18. 1 vase, minimum of 3 different herbs

SECTION B: Fruit

Apples

19. 5 dessert with stalks
20. 5 cooking with stalks

Plums/damsons

21. 5 with bloom and stalk intact

Raspberries

22. 1 plate of 12 - 1 variety

Other fruit

23. 1 melon OR 3 nectarines/peaches OR 6 apricots OR Kiwi fruits, 12 strawberries OR 12 cherries OR 12 blackberries OR 6 trusses of cane fruits

SECTION C: Flowers and Pot Plants

Dahlias

24. 1 vase, 3 stems of 1 variety – uniformity important
25. 1 vase, 5 stems of any variety or colour.

Roses

26. 1 specimen bloom
27. 1 vase of 3 blooms – 1 or more variety

Garden/allotment flowers (annuals or perennials)

28. 1 vase -1 variety of 6 stems
29. 1 vase – mixed varieties of 6 stems

Foliage or seed heads (can be mixed)

30. 1 vase of 5 stems of different species

Pot plants – max pot diameter 25cms

32. Foliage plant
33. Succulent

3. Entries must be made on the official form and reach the Entry Secretary not later than **12 noon on Thursday 20th July** with the appropriate entry fee. Entries later than 12 noon will incur an additional fee.
4. Exhibitors may enter **ONLY 1** exhibit in each class.
5. At 11.15 am. non-judges will be excluded from the Show Area.
6. Exhibitors must provide their own vases, dishes, paper plates, etc.
7. Cleaning of exhibits must be done before they are brought into Forward House.
8. An exhibit card will be available for each entry, to be placed face down when the exhibit is set up. **Exhibitors wishing to keep their exhibits should mark their exhibit card "Reserved" on the front, top right corner. Collection after the raffle.**
9. If judging is close, preference will be given to entries that are correctly named.
10. The judges may modify or withhold any award if the standard of exhibits does not merit a prize. **The decision of the judges will be final.** In all other matters connected to the Show, the decision of the committee shall be final.
11. Once staged, no exhibit can be removed until the raffle is drawn. Reserved exhibits may be removed at this stage. All unclaimed exhibits will be sold at auction on the next day at the Park Road site. Proceeds will go to K.H.S. funds or our nominated charity for 2017.
12. The Society accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits, display material, personal property or any personal injury, due to any cause whatsoever.
13. Challenge cups remain the property of the Society and will be held by the winners for one year only. These must be returned at least two weeks before the Show. No cup can be won outright.

Please put "Reserved" on your exhibit cards if you wish to take them home.

Rules of the 2017 Annual Show

1. **Exhibitors must be amateurs.** All exhibits in Sections A, B and C must have been grown by the exhibitor.
2. All exhibits in Sections D, F and G must have been completed since the 2016 Show. Pot plants must have been in the exhibitor's possession for at least 6 months.
