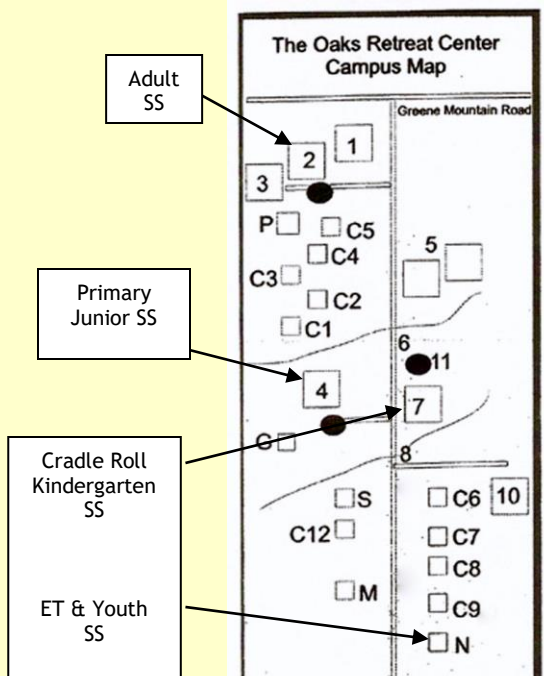


The Oaks Retreat Camp Map

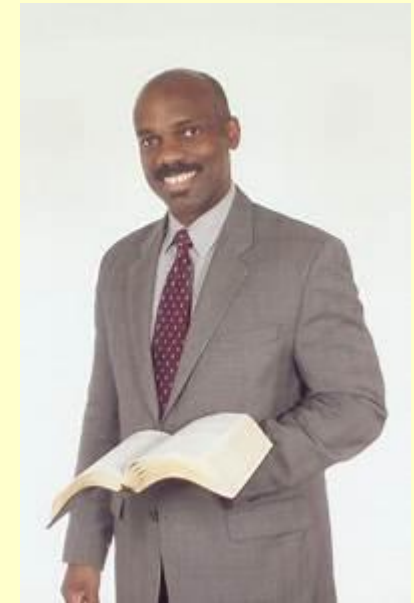

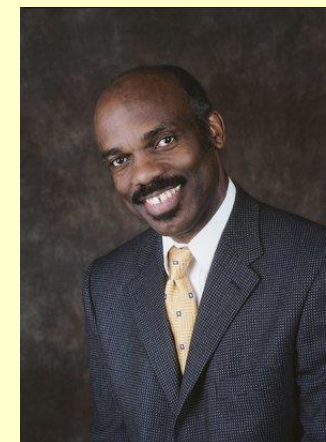
