TRANSPORT OPTIONS

The main public transport available for the Mosman area and on the Northern Beaches is buses. These connect to main train stations at Chatswood, North Sydney and the city as well as the ferry wharf at Manly. The main bus interchanges are at Spit Road at Mosman, Military Road at Mosman and Neutral Bay, Pittwater Road at Brookvale, Dee Why and Mona Vale, Warringah Road at Dee Why, Beacon Hill, and Frenches Forest and Manly Wharf.

Residents and ratepayers displaying a Northern Beaches Council Beach Parking Permit have free parking at more than 40 Northern Beaches locations. However, Manly's beachfront metered parking spaces along North and South Steyne are limited to four hours free parking.

For those without a Northern Beaches Council Beach Parking Permit. There are a number of designated pay and display parking areas throughout the Northern Beaches where payment for parking applies at various times between the hours of 6am and 9pm every day.



All vehicles parking at a Northern Beaches Council pay and display carpark or reserve are required to either display a valid pay and display ticket or a valid permit (permitted sites only). This also applies to motor bikes and parking tickets/permits should be displayed in a special holder secured to the vehicle which is the responsibility of the rider.

Please always check signage for the time restrictions and conditions of the carpark as well as the information displayed on the parking machines.
