

# Montessori Materials List

**2018-2019 Dear Parents, Only the following starred items are required at this time All children, please bring the following:**

1 box of 10 Crayola broad line markers either Classic or Bright colors 1 set of Crayola Pip Squeak markers (SKINNIES) Scotch tape for a tape dispenser \*Elmer's Glue Sticks (Package of 6 to 8) Package of #2 pencils (12) Ticonderoga brand 1 Box of 36 Crayola colored pencils (need to be Crayola) \*1 each of the following colors:Green, Red, Light Blue, Yellow, Orange plain 2 pocket paper folder without brads Please do not put name on folders \*1 Ream of white copy paper for everyone (only Kindergarten students) \*2 pieces of dark blue poster board 22" x 28" to be used for mapping (Please label tag with your child's name) \*2 pieces of white poster board 22" x 28"to be used for mapping (Please label tag with your child's name) \*Regular sized BACKPACK (The plastic envelope and many of our Montessori works that will be coming home will not fit into a smaller backpack.) \*A clear plastic envelope that will be needed for "take home" work will be purchased at school. \*A daily clean cloth napkin is to be included in your child's backpack regardless of whether your child brings his/her lunch or is part of the school lunch program. If your child brings lunch, please place the cloth napkin in the lunchbox. If your child is participating in the school lunch program, please place the cloth napkin in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on the bag. A paper towel is not a substitute for a cloth napkin.

\*EXTRA CLOTHING: All children will need to bring extra clothing for their lockers. All clothing should be labeled with your child's name and placed in a 1 Gallon Ziploc type bag labeled with your child's name, as well. The following items should be in the bag: navy pants, red shirt, 2 pair of underwear and 1 pair of socks.

**\*All children need to have a seasonal pair of indoor shoes to wear in the classroom. Warmer weather: soft mesh like water shoes or soft velcro strapped sandals. Colder weather: PLAIN SLIPPERS: No characters on the slippers will be permitted. All slippers need to have a hard rubber sole, a cloth top, and a strap across the top of the slippers. Zappos is a great website. No Crocs please.**

**No TIE SHOES of any kind are permitted in school (including gym shoes) unless your child is proficient in tying and double tying his/her shoes. Independence is a key component in Montessori.**

**\*Every child (who is not a Kindergartener) will need to bring an ELLIE and LUKE nap mat. No substitutes PLEASE! They are available on AMAZON. Place child's name on the nap mat.**

Depending on the enrollment, parents will be asked to sign-up at the beginning of the year for at least two/three weeks of snack. The Wednesday before your designated snack week, I will send home a list of items to be purchased for snack. All the items on the list, will be brought in on the following Monday. The snack will usually include starches, fruits, vegetables, and any other items necessary for the week. For example, paper towels, baggies, hand sanitizer, kleenex, etc...
