EU Work Plan for Sport 2017–2020

- Inspired by the Commission's report (January 2017)
- Adopted on: 23 May 2017
- Duration: 3 years and a half (until December 2020)
- Shared responsibilities
- Less outputs
- Diversification of methods

EU Work Plan for Sport 2017–2020

Priorities:

- Integrity of sport
- Economic dimension of sport
- Sport and society

Expert Groups:

- Integrity (including good governance)
- Skills and human resources development in sport

Other working methods: cluster meetings, conferences, seminars, groups of interested Member States, ...

Erasmus+ Sport chapter

- **Funding for sport and physical activity projects**
- Duration: **7 years (2014-2020)**
- Specific Sport chapter: **1.8 %**
- Total budget for Sport: **EUR 265.9 mln**
- Budget for 2017: **EUR 45.2 mln**
- **Small Collaborative Partnerships**
- Current 2017 call:
 - Deadline 6 April 2017
 - Results due mid-summer
 - 410 applications received
 - 154 on Small Collaborative Partnerships



Good governance

- 4 Outputs (EU Work Plan for Sport 2014–17):
 - Gender equality
 - Major sport events
 - Protection of minors
 - Good Governance principle
- Follow-up of the Expert Group on Good Governance
 - Priority in the new EU Work Plan for Sport
- Commission pledge on Good Governance
 - 50 signatories soon (European sport federations, NOCs, EWoS partners)

Calls for proposals: refugees and anti-radicalisation

- "Sport and refugees" 2016 call – *implementation phase*
- **2017**: 2 specific calls for proposals, based on the EP initiative (Pilot Projects)
 - **Sport as a tool for integration and social inclusion of refugees – budget € 1M**
 - **Monitoring and coaching, through sports, of youngsters at risk of radicalisation – budget € 750.000**
- Possibility to fund respectively about 20 and 15 project, max. € 60.000 per project, max. 80% of their budget
- Publication of both calls likely in end-June
- Projects to be implemented in 2018
