



## NIGHTRIDER 2019 CHARITY PLACES TERMS & CONDITIONS

### Nightrider 2019 Events:

- London: 8/9 June
- Glasgow: 22/23 June
- Bristol: 6/7 July
- Liverpool: 13/14 July

### Terms & Conditions:

1. The cost of a charity place on Nightrider 2019 is £60 inclusive of VAT, unless you are a Tour Partner when it is reduced to £55 per place for purchasing 100 places.
2. The minimum purchase for a charity is 5 places.
3. Once purchased, charity places are non-refundable.
4. **Unused Places – If you fill 80% or more of the places you purchased two weeks prior to the event, the remaining unsold places will be rolled over to Nightrider 2020. This is provided you buy a minimum of 10 places in 2019. If you fill less than 80% of the places you purchased, you will not be able to transfer any places over to 2020. There is no refund for any unused places. Places can only be transferred to Nightrider 2020 events.**
5. You will need to pay for the number of charity places you are buying in full. Places will be sold on a first come, first served basis.
6. Once you have purchased your initial places, you will be able to buy more places if you need to, subject to availability.
7. It is your responsibility to send your charity's logo to the Nightrider team to be featured on the Nightrider website after the purchase of your Charity Places and to update us if your logo changes.
8. If a participant raising funds for your charity cancels for any reason, their place is returned to your charity to sell to another supporter up to two weeks prior to the event.
9. Charity Places are only valid on the Nightrider event you select to purchase them in.
10. You will have access to an online report which will give you full details of your participants. It is your responsibility to check this and collect the participant details. All participants are aware their details are being passed on to you.
11. If a participant advises us they are no longer participating, we will advise you and remove them from your report. You are responsible for updating Classic Challenge of any participants that you are aware are no longer participating in the event.
12. Your charity is responsible for promoting the event to your supporters. Promotional material including text, images and video will be provided to help you.
13. Nightrider registration will close two weeks prior to the event date. No registrations will be accepted after this time.
14. Each participant who registers on Nightrider will do so on the Nightrider website using the registration system. They will be required to pay a Registration Fee when they sign up which will be:
  - £29 – for all registrations before 31 December 2018
  - £35 – for all registrations before 31 March 2019
  - £45 – for all registrations before the event deadline
15. Registration Fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
