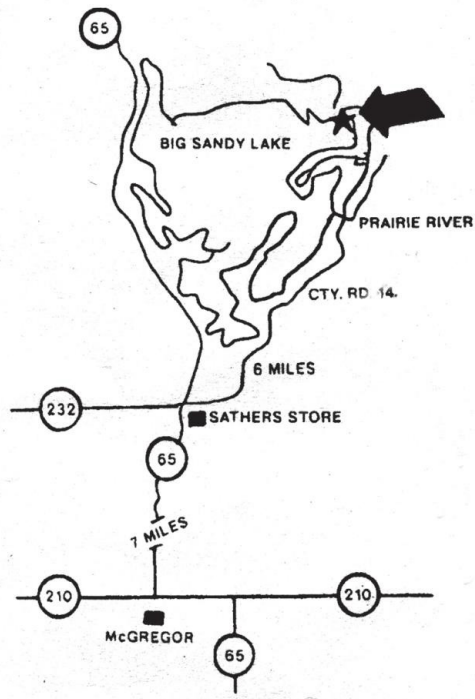

From the Dairy Queen on Highway 65, travel 7 miles north of McGregor, MN. At Sather's Store, turn right onto County Road 14 (opposite Hwy 232) proceed approximately 6 miles. Just beyond the Big Sandy Community Church, turn left onto County Road 36/Loon Ave. Proceed ¼ mile (bottom of hill) and turn left onto 184th or 185th Place. **Please Note:** Signs will indicate the route to Big Sandy Camp from Sather's Store.
