## **Mature cataract**

Entire lens has become opaque.



## **Posterior Subcapsular cataract**


A common cataract with vision particularly hampered by bright light.



## **Cortical cataract**

Spoke formation involving the lens cortex.

## **Capsular Pseudoexfoliation cataract**


An opacity located in the outer portion of the lens.



## **Nuclear cataract**

The most common cataract. The lens nucleus becomes brown and eventually entire lens is affected.

# CATARACTS

Cataracts affect the transparency of the lens causing a broad range of visual loss. In the most mild case, there is a barely detectable blur. As the disease progresses, impairment can be so profound that the patient can see only light and no shapes or movement.
