UNITED NATIONS BLUE HELMETS – SOLDIERS OF PEACE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION (SPIA)

The International Peacekeepers Association is an international NGO that was founded on November 19th 1988. The IPSA has had Category I consultative status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (ECOSOC) since 1995. The organization, comprising the Blue Helmets, has a head office based in Lyon, France and offices around the world. The organization has nearly 60,000 member.

Their fields of action are the management of military conflicts and peace-building, demining (elimination of antipersonnel mines with the awareness of the affected populations), human rights, technical and pragmatic training for peace and humanitarian aid, in particular by setting up education programs and building schools.

On some occasions, the SPIA awards commemorative peace medals to congratulate and thank certain personalities for their humanitarian commitment to a better world.



When it comes to travel, access to the seas and oceans, family trips, the opportunity to immerse oneself in a cultural experience, etc., WAW aims to change mentalities, raising awareness so that there is a genuine understanding in the tourist industry and in institutions about the importance of making public places, transport and housing accessible to the greatest number of people.



Since 2013, Wheeling Around the World (WAW) has been the preferred spokesperson for people with reduced mobility in terms of holidays and business trips.



Whether by developing projects, supporting other associations, taking part in one-off actions, conducting missions around the world or participating in the media, the foundation wants to shift the lines and prove to everyone that "nothing is impossible to the one who walks within his head" - the slogan of the foundation.

Wheeling Around the World's new mission is the creation of a large motor-home bus to enable people with reduced mobility to travel easily throughout Europe and offer the possibility of going on holiday to those who can't afford it. With a capacity of six people, this motor home will be fully designed to accommodate one or more people in wheelchairs and their families or friends.

It will be equipped with a master bedroom, two separate beds, a sofa bed, an accessible bathroom, a kitchenette and a relaxation area. Driven by professional drivers, the Wheeling Around the World motorhome will be able to travel all over Europe with a different group every week.



It offers total freedom of movement, allowing participants to tailor their trip according to their desires, without having to worry about finding accessible accommodation at each stage. This type of large accessible motorhome is already available in the United States and Australia, but it does not exist yet in Europe.

The association therefore relies on charitable events and the generosity of partners, sponsors and donors to finance this project (total value of about € 750,000). The association also wants to use this motorhome as a powerful mean of communication and lobbying at an international level

At the age of sixteen, Alexandre Bodart Pinto suffered a serious motorcycle accident that made him paraplegic. After a long period of rehabilitation, he began studying commerce and marketing and decided that his condition should not prevent him from living fully and fulfilling his dreams.

During his studies, he launched his first event company and opened his own nightclub in Brussels. Two years later, in 2008, he sold his establishment to create VIP BELGIUM.

For the past ten years, Alexandre Bodart Pinto has made a name for himself in the business of prestigious events.



His activities allow him to meet and collaborate with a considerable number of business leaders, opinion leaders, members of the Jet-Set and more than 300 celebrities such as Bruce Willis, Will Smith, Penelope Cruz, Paris Hilton, Akon, Michelle Rodriguez, Prince Albert of Monaco, Eva Longoria, the Jackson family, Jean-Claude Van Damme, Cuba Gooding JR or Alain Delon and Jean-Paul Belmondo.

Always passionate about travel, Alexandre founded the association Wheeling Around the World in 2013.

Today, Alexandre is more active than ever. Always on the lookout for new challenges.
