## EAST-CENTRAL AFRICA DIVISION HEALTH MINISTRIES DEPARTEMNT VISION 2020

- 1. To underline Health Evangelism by holding a Lifestyle Health Certification Program for 2,080 church members as Trainers-of-Trainers (TOT's) by 2020.
- a. At least train 180 TOT's in EKUC, WKUC, UU, and NTUC, STUM by 2017
- b. At least train 160 TOT's in EU, RU, and WCU by 2018
- c. At least train 140 TOT's in NECUM, ECU, BA, SSAT, and EMF by 2019
- 2. To emphasize Health Education in ECD by:
- a. Presenting regular features "The Health Bound..." in ECD Webpage.
- b. Have a one page inserts every week in the SS Bible Study Guide Quarterly
- c. Utilize AWR & Hope Channel to promote the Health and Temperance messages
- d. Encourage the local churches to conduct regular health programs as in-reach and outreach ministries (Breathe Free Program, nutrition classes, etc.)
- e. Incorporating Adventists health principles in all Adventist schools and colleges corecurriculum by 2020.
- f. To have a quarterly division-wide health magazine in collaboration with ECD Publishing Department by 2020.
- 3. To organize Leadership training in each health care institutions in ECD by 2020.
- a. To hold a division wide leadership seminar and health advisory by June 2016
- b. To conduct Quest for Quality workshop for the health-care institutions by 2019
- c. To hold leadership seminars in each institutions a total of 10 seminars by 2020
- d. To realize networking among ECD Union hospitals by 2020
- 4. To conduct Health survey, called Appreciative enquiry, for ECD Union hospitals with GC Health Ministries every 4 years (had conducted one in 2004, 2008, 2012) the next one is on 2016.
- 5. To have regular evaluations of the Nursing Schools with ECD Education Director and GC Health Ministries every 4 years (had conducted one in 2004 & 2008, 2012) the next is one is due in 2016.

- 6. To raise 50% the hospitals and clinics in ECD to self-supporting status by 2020
- 7. To recruit national doctors, nurses and allied health personnel by 2020 and beyond for each hospitals and clinics and health ministries department of the Union in ECD territory.
- 8. To utilize the bursary fund at ECD for training doctors, nurses, etc by 2020.
- a. at least each union sponsors one medical doctor/dental surgeon by 2020
- b. at least each union sponsors one or two nurses/allied health professionals every year by 2020
- 9. To organize ICPA Chapters in ECD with the Executive director of ICPA-I, GC
- a. To strengthen the ICPA Chapter in EAU (organized 1982)
- b. To revive the new ICPA Chapter in TU, EUM, & UU (organized in 2005/06)
- c. To open ICPA Chapter in RU, & SSAT by 2016
- d. To open one ICPA Chapter in the remaining ECD Union's by 2020
- 10. To roll out and scale up the creative ministry in ECD by 2020
- a. To expand/strengthen our health services in Diibouti by 2019
- b. To build or buy a building for a dental clinic in Eritrea by 2020
- c. To build and open a dental clinic in Somalia by 2020
- d. To participate in the minority ministry (street kids, drug addicts, etc.) by 2019
- 11. To organize the Seventh-day Adventist Dietetic Association in ECD by 2020.
- 12. To roll out and scale up our response to HIV/AIDS epidemic in ECD in collaboration with Adventist AIDS International Ministry (AAIM) or HIV/AIDS office for Africa:
- a. To sponsor 100 training sessions in churches on HIV/AIDS by 2020
- b. To encourage all the unions to appoint HIV/AIDS coordinator by 2017
- c. To hold a division-wide leadership seminar on HIV/AIDS-follow-up meeting by 2017
- d. ECD HIV/AIDS Commission to formulate policies governing HIV/AIDS prevention, care, treatment, and support in our church, schools, universities by 2020.
- e. To train 3,000 trainers and 2,500 peer-educators by 2020
- f. To collaborate with the AAIM and others in response to income generating program and OVC, etc.
- g. To continue training the pastors, church leaders in counseling and support
- h. To come up with interdepartmental commitments to HIV/AIDS crisis responses in the local churches, schools, health care institutions in ECD.

- 13. To encourage the health ministries directors at all levels (Union/Fields/Conferences/local churches) for interdepartmental and integrated collaborative activities and events in all church programs, like camp meetings, evangelistic campaign, week of prayers, Youth programs, HIV/AIDS programs, etc.
- 14. To strengthen the Comprehensive Health Ministry Initiatives in ECD as the initiatives enters to its Second Phase (2015 2016).
- 15. To open a medical school in ECD in collaboration with ECD Education department and the Adventist University of Central Africa, Kigali, Rwanda by 2017.
