

Whereas the Governing Board of “Na Ho’omaka Hou” recognizes that education of the whole child is essential to the development of happy, healthy, socially conscious adults, and


Whereas the Governing Board of “Na Ho’omaka Hou” desires to make a determined effort to provide such educational opportunity for all students in West Hawaii, be it
