Kelly saw the dedication of faculty and staff to preparing students for the real-world business environment as they made efforts to assist in resume building, etiquette and other soft skills.

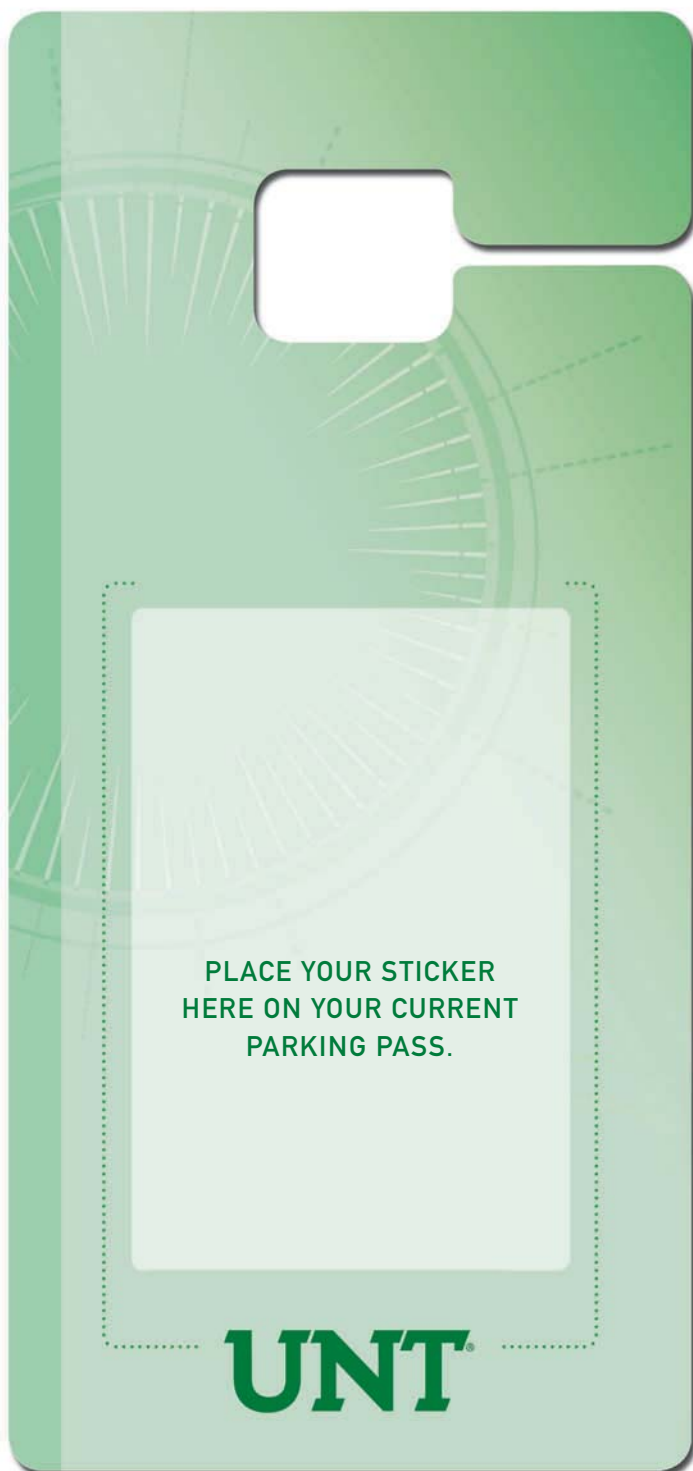

PARKING PASS REMINDERS

- Your pass provides access to parking spaces marked as **D (blue)**, **G (brown)** and **P (gold)** and visitor-designated parking spaces on the UNT campus. It also enables you to park in the garages by scanning the wafer chip on the back of your pass at the garage gate. You are responsible for any violations should you park in an unauthorized space.
- Parking privileges will depend on the university's ability to provide this privilege and will be evaluated on an annual basis.
- One parking pass per household will be issued.
- Your pass is reusable by affixing the included annual renewal sticker, as illustrated at left.
- Damaged passes will be replaced at no charge upon return of the damaged pass.
- Lost or stolen passes should be reported immediately and will be canceled. A replacement pass will be provided at no cost.
