Notes can be sorted into folders, then tagged, annotated, edited, given comments, searched and exported as part of a notebook. Notability 	This app integrates handwriting, PDF annotation, typing, recording, and organizing. It features synced audio (similar to smartpen), multiple fonts, colors, styles, and sizes. It can also include photos, figures, and webpages. The text will automatically wrap around these objects. You can upload a PDF of any note to Dropbox.	http://www.gingerlabs.com/
Awesome Note 	Awesome Note HD is an innovative notetaking application and to-do manager for iPad that allows you to combine notes with to-do lists. Notes and folders created in Awesome Note can be synchronized with your Evernote account, and if you edit those notes in Evernote, your changes are synchronized back into Awesome Note so that your notes stay up-to-date no matter where you're reading them. Whink 	A similar option to Notability. Whink allows students to draw or type notes, or record audio notes. Students can collaborate and share notes, and keep them organized both on their device and on the web. One Note 	Microsoft OneNote is a notetaking and list making app that syncs across all devices. Features include the ability to share notes, highlight, draw, and enter text. With the Microsoft Surface, you can also use a pen for handwriting or marking up text. <p>MOLESKINE Smart Writing System</p>	<p>The Moleskin Smart Writing System is an analog-to-digital note-taking set that comes with a notebook, smart pen, and Moleskin Notes app. You can take notes in real time on physical paper, and it automatically syncs to your phone or tablet. The notes can then be edited and filed according to subject. Another cool feature is the ability to sync a paper planner with Google Calendar or iCal. One downfall is that the planner is only a 5x8 IN, which isn't large enough for many students. <p>reMarkable</p>	<p>reMarkable is a paper tablet that's designed to replace notebooks while keeping that paper feel intact. Students can use it for reading, writing, notetaking, and sketching.
